# Igloo ICE103 Counter Top Ice Maker User Manual

# **PRODUCT OVERVIEW**

The Igloo ICE103 Counter Top Ice Maker is designed for convenient and efficient ice production. This portable unit features an over-sized ice basket with a capacity of 2.2 lbs, capable of producing up to 26 lbs of ice per day. It offers three ice cube sizes (small, medium, or large) and is controlled via an electronic panel with LED indicators. The included 4-ounce stainless steel ice scoop is a durable accessory for serving ice.

#### SETUP AND INSTALLATION

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ice maker and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit, especially at the rear and sides.
- 3. Initial Cleaning: Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker.

- Wipe the interior with a soft cloth dampened with warm water and a mild detergent.
- Rinse thoroughly and drain any remaining water.
- Clean the ice scoop with warm soapy water and dry completely.
- 4. Power Connection: Plug the ice maker into a grounded 115 Volt electrical outlet.

# **Control Panel Overview**

- ADD WATER Indicator: Illuminates when the water reservoir needs refilling.
- ICE FULL Indicator: Illuminates when the ice basket is full.
- Size Selection (L/S): Indicates the currently selected ice cube size (Large or Small).
- **SELECT Button:** Press to cycle through available ice cube sizes.
- ON/OFF Button: Powers the unit on or off.

#### Making Ice

- 1. Fill Water Reservoir: Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line. Do not overfill.
- 2. Power On: Press the ON/OFF button to start the ice making process.
- 3. **Select Ice Size:** Press the **SELECT** button to choose your desired ice cube size (Small or Large). The corresponding LED will illuminate.
- 4. Ice Production: The unit will begin producing ice. The first batch of ice can be ready in as little as 6 minutes.
- 5. **Ice Collection:** When the **ICE FULL** indicator illuminates, the ice basket is full. Remove ice using the provided scoop. The unit will pause production until ice is removed.
- 6. Refilling Water: When the ADD WATER indicator illuminates, refill the reservoir to continue ice production.

# MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Igloo ICE103 Ice Maker.

# 1. Daily Cleaning:

- After each use, drain any remaining water from the reservoir.
- Wipe the interior and exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.

#### 2. Weekly Cleaning:

- · Unplug the unit.
- · Remove the ice basket.
- Clean the water reservoir and ice basket with a solution of warm water and mild dish soap.
- · Rinse all components thoroughly with clean water.
- Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling and storing or using again.

#### 3. Descaling (Monthly or as needed):

- To remove mineral deposits, mix a solution of water and vinegar (1:1 ratio) or a commercial descaling agent.
- · Pour the solution into the water reservoir.
- Run the ice maker for a few cycles (without consuming the ice) to circulate the solution.
- Drain the solution completely and rinse the reservoir multiple times with fresh water to remove any residue or odor.
- 4. **Storage:** If storing the ice maker for an extended period, ensure it is thoroughly cleaned and dried. Store in a cool, dry place.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not turning on.	No power, unit not plugged in, power button not pressed.	Ensure unit is plugged into a working outlet. Press the <b>ON/OFF</b> button. Check circuit breaker.
"ADD WATER" indicator is on.	Water reservoir is empty or water level is too low.	Fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line.
"ICE FULL" indicator is on.	Ice basket is full.	Remove ice from the ice basket. The unit will resume production automatically.
No ice is being made or ice is not forming correctly.	Water level too low, ambient temperature too high, air vent blocked, ice blockage.	<ul> <li>Ensure water reservoir is filled.</li> <li>Place unit in a cooler environment.</li> <li>Ensure air vents are not obstructed.</li> <li>If there is an ice blockage, turn off the machine. Start the machine after the ice block melts. Or change the size selector to small ice cubes.</li> </ul>

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice cubes are too small or soft.	Water temperature too high, first few cycles, ambient temperature.	Use colder water. The first few cycles may produce smaller ice. Ensure unit is in a cool environment. Select a larger ice size if available.
