YATOUR TOY2-Y Adapter Cable User Manual for Toyota/Lexus 6+6Pin Radios

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation and operation of the YATOUR TOY2-Y Adapter Cable. This adapter is specifically designed for select Toyota and Lexus vehicles equipped with 6+6Pin navigation or AUX radios where the CD changer port is already occupied. The Y-cable allows for the integration of a YATOUR Car Bluetooth Adapter, AUX, or USB SD Music CD adapter, enabling modern audio connectivity while retaining the factory head unit.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The YATOUR TOY2-Y Adapter Cable is a specialized wiring harness that facilitates the connection of additional audio devices to compatible Toyota and Lexus factory radios. It acts as a bridge, allowing multiple devices to share the existing CD changer port.

SETUP

1. Identifying the CD Changer Port

Locate the 6+6Pin CD changer port at the rear of your Toyota or Lexus factory radio. This port is typically used for external CD changers or navigation systems. The YATOUR TOY2-Y adapter cable is necessary if this port is already in use by another accessory (e.g., NAV, AUX) and you wish to add another YATOUR device.

2. Connecting the YATOUR Adapter Cable

1. Carefully remove your car's factory radio from the dashboard. Refer to your vehicle's service manual for specific instructions on radio removal.
2. Disconnect the existing cable from the 6+6Pin CD changer port on the back of the radio.
3. Connect one end of the YATOUR TOY2-Y adapter cable to the now-vacant 6+6Pin CD changer port on the radio.
4. Connect the cable that was originally removed from the radio to the corresponding female connector on the YATOUR TOY2-Y adapter cable.
5. Connect your YATOUR Car Bluetooth Adapter, AUX, or USB SD Music CD adapter to the remaining female connector on the YATOUR TOY2-Y adapter cable.
6. Ensure all connections are secure.
7. Carefully reinstall the factory radio into the dashboard.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Activating the Adapter

After installation, turn on your car's ignition and the factory radio. Press the 'CD' or 'DISC' button on your radio to switch to the CD changer input. This action will activate the YATOUR adapter and any connected devices.

2. Bluetooth Audio Streaming

If you have connected a YATOUR Car Bluetooth Adapter:

1. Ensure your Bluetooth adapter is powered on (it receives power through the Y-cable).
2. On your mobile device, navigate to Bluetooth settings and search for available devices.
3. Select the YATOUR Bluetooth device (usually named 'YATOUR' or similar) to pair.
4. Once paired, you can stream audio from your mobile device directly through your car's speakers. Control playback (play/pause, skip tracks) using your mobile device or, if supported, your car's steering wheel controls.

3. Auxiliary (AUX) Input

If you have connected a YATOUR device with an AUX input:

1. Connect your external audio device (e.g., MP3 player, smartphone) to the AUX input port on the YATOUR device using a 3.5mm audio cable.
2. Select the AUX input mode on your YATOUR device (refer to its specific manual for details).
3. Audio from your external device will now play through your car's speakers. Volume control can be managed via the car radio or the external device.

4. USB Playback

If you have connected a YATOUR device with a USB input:

1. Insert a USB flash drive containing MP3/WMA audio files into the USB port on the YATOUR device.
2. The YATOUR device should automatically detect the USB drive and begin playback.
3. Use the radio's track/folder buttons to navigate through your music files.

MAINTENANCE

The YATOUR TOY2-Y Adapter Cable requires minimal maintenance. Ensure all connections remain secure and free from dust or moisture. Avoid excessive pulling or bending of the cables to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Audio Output:** Ensure the radio is set to the correct CD changer input. Check all cable connections for tightness. Verify that the connected YATOUR device is powered on and functioning correctly.
- **Bluetooth Pairing Issues:** Make sure the YATOUR Bluetooth adapter is in pairing mode. Delete previous pairings from your mobile device and attempt to re-pair. Ensure no other devices are actively connected to the Bluetooth adapter.
- **Intermittent Audio:** Check for loose connections at both the radio and the YATOUR adapter. Ensure the Y-cable is not pinched or damaged.
- **USB Playback Errors:** Verify that the USB flash drive is formatted correctly (FAT32) and contains compatible audio files (MP3/WMA). Try a different USB drive to rule out drive issues.
