GUESS GU 2658 Women's Eyeglasses Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use, care, and maintenance of your new GUESS GU 2658 women's eyeglasses. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your eyewear. Retain this manual for future reference.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The GUESS GU 2658 eyeglasses are designed with a focus on contemporary style and comfort. They feature a lightweight frame suitable for all-day wear.

2.1 Key Features

3. SETUP

Your GUESS GU 2658 eyeglasses are designed for immediate use after prescription lenses have been installed by a qualified optician.

3.1 Lens Installation

Take your eyeglasses frame to a professional optician for the installation of your prescription lenses. Attempting to install lenses yourself may damage the frame and void any warranty.

3.2 Initial Fitting

After lens installation, your optician will adjust the frame to ensure a comfortable and secure fit on your face. This may involve:

- Adjusting the temple arms for proper length and curve behind the ears.
- Adjusting the nose pads to sit comfortably and evenly on your nose bridge.
- Ensuring the frame sits level on your face.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your eyeglasses correctly helps maintain their condition and ensures clear vision.

4.1 Wearing Your Eyeglasses

1. Always use both hands to put on and take off your eyeglasses. Grasp the frame by the temples near the hinges. This prevents bending or misalignment of the frame.
2. Ensure the nose pads rest comfortably on your nose and the temple arms sit securely over your ears without causing pressure.

4.2 Handling and Storage

- When not wearing your eyeglasses, always store them in the provided protective carrying case.
- Avoid placing your eyeglasses face down on any surface to prevent scratching the lenses.
- Do not leave your eyeglasses in direct sunlight or in extreme heat (e.g., on a car dashboard), as this can damage the frame material and lens coatings.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and proper care will extend the life of your GUESS GU 2658 eyeglasses.

5.1 Cleaning the Lenses

1. Rinse your lenses under lukewarm running water to remove dust and debris. Avoid hot water, which can damage lens coatings.
2. Apply a small drop of mild, lotion-free dish soap to each lens. Gently rub both sides of the lenses and all parts of the frame.
3. Rinse thoroughly with lukewarm water.
4. Gently dry the lenses and frame with a clean, soft microfiber cloth specifically designed for eyeglasses. Avoid using paper towels, tissues, or clothing, as these can scratch the lenses.

5.2 Cleaning the Frame

The frame can be cleaned using the same method as the lenses. Pay attention to areas around the nose pads and hinges where dirt and oils can accumulate.

5.3 Periodic Adjustments

Over time, your eyeglasses may require minor adjustments due to normal wear. If your eyeglasses feel loose, crooked, or uncomfortable, visit your optician for professional adjustment. Avoid attempting to bend or adjust the frame yourself, as this can cause damage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter with your eyeglasses.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Eyeglasses slip down nose	Loose fit, nose pads too wide	Visit an optician for adjustment of nose pads and temple arms.
Eyeglasses feel crooked	Frame bent, temple arms misaligned	Visit an optician for professional realignment.
Lenses are smudged/dirty	Fingerprints, dust, oils	Clean lenses as described in Section 5.1. Use a clean microfiber cloth.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Screws are loose	Normal wear and tear	Gently tighten with a small eyewear screwdriver. Do not overtighten. If unsure, visit an optician.
