1. INTRODUCTION

The PNY 64GB Duo Link iOS USB 3.0 OTG Flash Drive is designed to expand storage for your iPhone and iPad, enabling seamless transfer of photos, videos, and other digital content to and from your computer. This device also facilitates contact backup and can charge your iOS devices simultaneously during data transfer. This manual provides essential information for its proper use and maintenance.

2. SETUP

2.1. App Installation

To use the PNY Duo Link with your iOS device, you must first download and install the free **Duo Link 4** app from the Apple App Store. This app is essential for managing files and performing backups.

2.2. Connecting to an iOS Device

1. Ensure the Duo Link 4 app is installed on your iPhone or iPad.
2. Connect the Lightning connector end of the PNY Duo Link to your iOS device's charging port.
3. The Duo Link 4 app should automatically launch or prompt you to open it. If not, open the app manually.

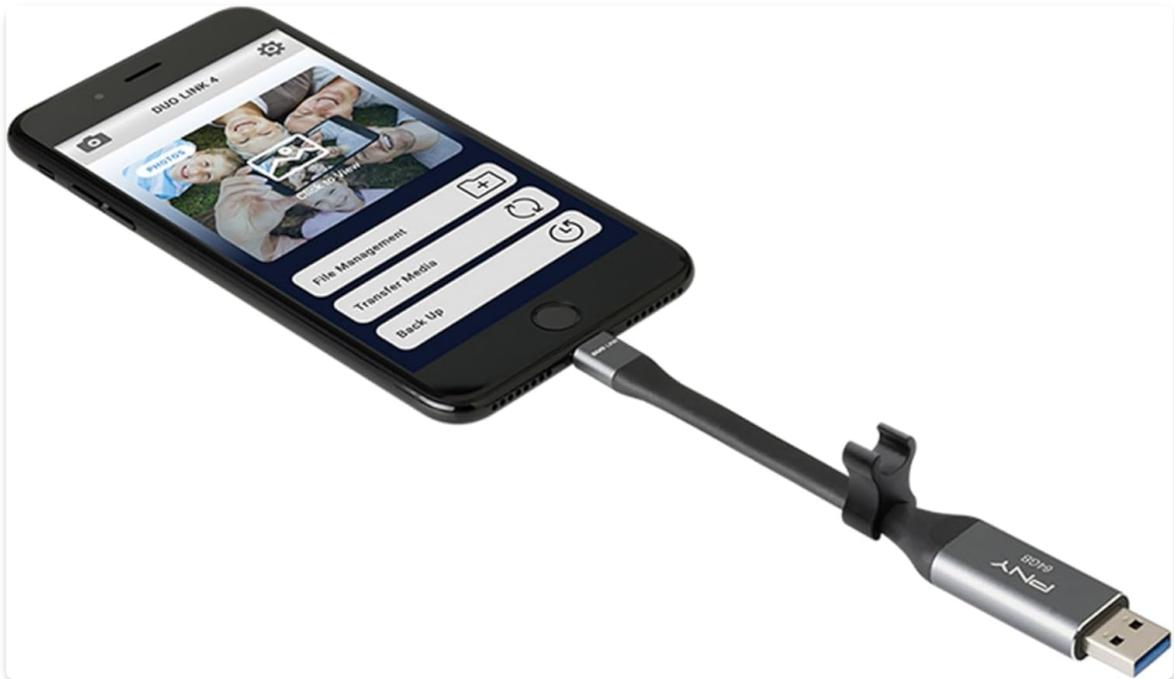


Image 2.1: The PNY Duo Link connected to an iPhone, displaying the Duo Link 4 app interface.

2.3. Connecting to a Computer

To transfer files from the Duo Link to your computer, or to access stored files, connect the USB 3.0 connector end of the PNY Duo Link to an available USB port on your desktop or laptop computer. The device will appear as a removable storage drive.

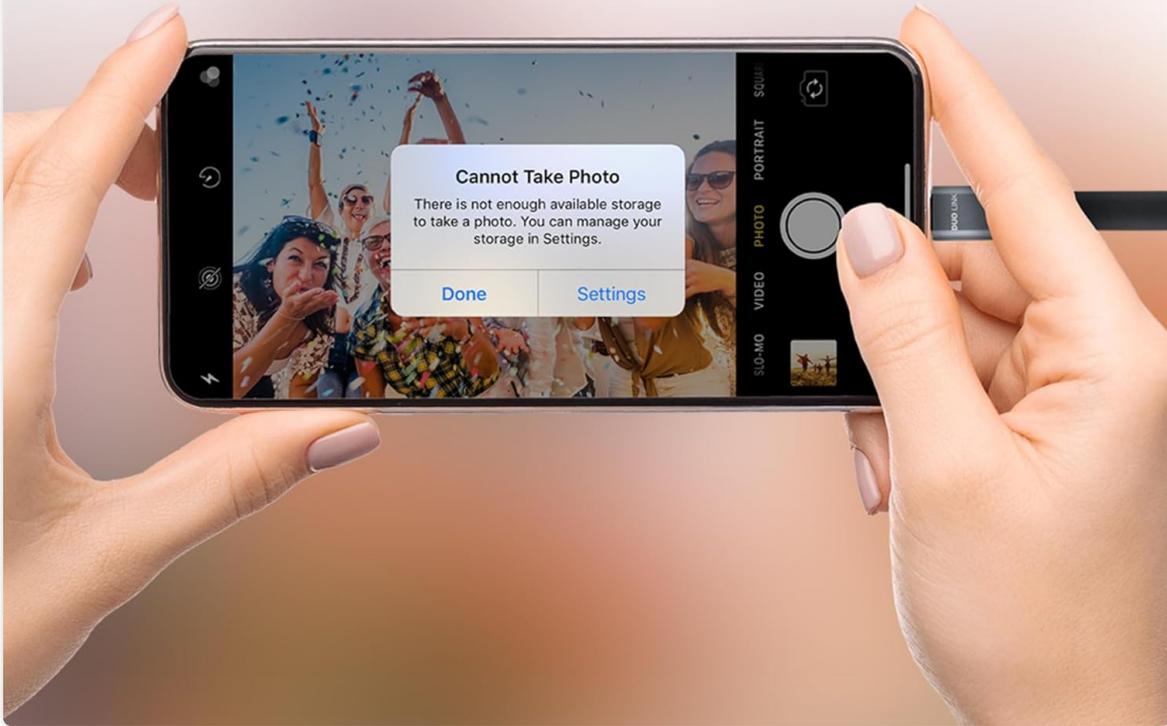


Image 3.1: An iPhone displaying a 'Cannot Take Photo' message due to insufficient storage, highlighting the need for external storage.

3.2. Transferring Files (Photos, Videos, Contacts)

1. Connect the Duo Link to your iOS device and open the Duo Link 4 app.
2. Navigate to the 'Transfer Media' or 'Backup' section within the app.
3. Select the type of content you wish to transfer (e.g., Photos, Videos, Contacts).
4. Choose the specific files or select all items for transfer.
5. Follow the on-screen prompts to move the selected content to the Duo Link.

4. MAINTENANCE

- Keep the connectors clean and free from dust or debris. Use a soft, dry cloth for cleaning.
- Store the Duo Link in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid bending the flexible cable excessively to prevent damage.
- Do not attempt to disassemble the device, as this will void the warranty.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Solution
-------	-------------------

Issue	Possible Solution
Duo Link not recognized by iOS device.	Ensure the Duo Link 4 app is installed and updated. Disconnect and reconnect the drive. Restart your iOS device.
Duo Link not recognized by computer.	Ensure the USB 3.0 connector is fully inserted into a working USB port. Try a different USB port. Restart your computer.
Slow transfer speeds.	Ensure you are using a USB 3.0 port on your computer for optimal speeds. Transferring a large number of small files can be slower than a few large files.
Cannot transfer certain files.	Check the file types supported by the Duo Link 4 app. Ensure there is sufficient space on the Duo Link.
