#### **INTRODUCTION**

The Pyle PDWMKRHD20 is a compact home audio/video karaoke mixer designed to integrate microphone vocals with your existing audio and video systems. This device allows you to connect microphones, mix their audio with music from various sources, and output the combined sound and video to a display or speaker system. It features HDMI and auxiliary (3.5mm) input/output options, along with individual controls for music volume, microphone volume, echo, and tone.

# WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Please check the package contents to ensure all items are present:

- Microphone Receiver Base (PDWMKRHD20 unit)
- (2) Wired Microphones
- Audio Connection Cables (RCA and 3.5mm)
- Power Adapter

# **SETUP**

Follow these steps to connect your Pyle PDWMKRHD20 karaoke mixer to your audio/video system.

# 1. Connecting to a TV or Home Theater System (HDMI)

- 1. Connect an HDMI cable from your video source (e.g., media player, gaming console) to the HDMI IN port on the PDWMKRHD20 mixer.
- 2. Connect another HDMI cable from the **HDMI OUT** port on the PDWMKRHD20 mixer to an HDMI input on your TV or home theater receiver.
- 3. Ensure your TV or receiver is set to the correct HDMI input.

# 2. Connecting to Audio Devices (Auxiliary)

- 1. To connect an external audio source (e.g., smartphone, tablet) for music, use a 3.5mm audio cable from your device's headphone jack to the **AUX IN (3.5mm)** port on the PDWMKRHD20 mixer.
- 2. To output mixed audio to speakers or an amplifier without HDMI, connect a 3.5mm audio cable from the AUX OUT (3.5mm) port on the PDWMKRHD20 mixer to the audio input of your speakers or amplifier.

#### 3. Connecting Microphones

- 1. Plug the provided wired microphones into the MIC 1 and MIC 2 (1/4") input jacks on the front of the PDWMKRHD20 mixer.
- 2. Ensure the microphones are switched to the 'ON' position if they have an on/off switch.

#### 4. Power Connection

- 1. Connect the power adapter to the **DC 5V** input port on the rear of the PDWMKRHD20 mixer.
- 2. Plug the power adapter into a standard wall outlet.
- 3. Press the **POWER** button on the front panel to turn on the unit. The power indicator light will illuminate.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Once the unit is set up, you can begin using your Pyle PDWMKRHD20 karaoke mixer.

#### **Controls Overview**





- MUSIC Knob: Adjusts the overall volume of the background music from your connected audio/video source.
- MIC 1 / MIC 2 Knobs: Control the individual volume levels for Microphone 1 and Microphone 2.
- ECHO Knob: Adjusts the amount of echo effect applied to the microphone vocals.
- TONE Knob: Modifies the tonal quality (bass/treble) of the microphone vocals.
- POWER Button: Turns the unit on or off.

# **Basic Operation**

- 1. Turn on the PDWMKRHD20 mixer using the  $\mbox{\bf POWER}$  button.
- 2. Start playing music from your connected source (e.g., TV, media player, smartphone).
- 3. Adjust the MUSIC knob to your desired background music volume.
- 4. Ensure your microphones are connected and switched on.
- 5. Speak into the microphones and adjust the individual MIC 1 and MIC 2 knobs to set the vocal volume.

6. Experiment with the **ECHO** and **TONE** knobs to achieve your preferred vocal sound.

#### MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Pyle PDWMKRHD20 mixer, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit. Avoid using liquid cleaners, aerosols, or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the unit in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Handling: Handle the unit and microphones with care. Avoid dropping or subjecting them to strong impacts.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the unit has adequate ventilation and is not placed in an enclosed space that could lead to overheating.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If you encounter issues with your Pyle PDWMKRHD20 mixer, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from microphones	<ul> <li>Microphone not connected properly.</li> <li>Microphone switched off.</li> <li>Microphone volume knob turned down.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Ensure microphones are securely plugged into MIC 1/2 jacks.</li> <li>Switch microphones to 'ON'.</li> <li>Increase MIC 1/2 volume knobs.</li> </ul>
No music sound	<ul> <li>Audio source not playing or connected incorrectly.</li> <li>Music volume knob turned down.</li> <li>TV/receiver input incorrect.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Verify audio source is playing and connected to HDMI IN or AUX IN.</li> <li>Increase MUSIC volume knob.</li> <li>Select the correct HDMI or audio input on your TV/receiver.</li> </ul>
Distorted sound	<ul><li>Volume levels too high.</li><li>Poor cable connection.</li></ul>	<ul><li>Reduce MUSIC and MIC volume knobs.</li><li>Check all cable connections for secure fit.</li></ul>
No power	<ul><li>Power adapter not connected.</li><li>Power button not pressed.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Ensure power adapter is securely connected to the unit and wall outlet.</li> <li>Press the POWER button.</li> </ul>
