Product Overview

The Pop-A-Shot Home Dual Shot brings the arcade basketball experience into your home. This unit features high scores, two-player modes, announcers, and bonus time, offering engaging play without requiring screen interaction. It includes proprietary infrared sensors for nearly 100% accurate score tracking, 7 basketballs, 16 different game modes, a large 3-digit scoreboard, and 6 audio options. The game can be powered by AC or AA-batteries. Constructed from sturdy 1.5-inch steel tubes with powder coating, a heavy-duty nylon ramp, and a 1/2-inch thick commercial-grade backboard, it is designed for durability. The game dimensions are 46 inches wide x 88 inches deep, with an adjustable height of 82/88/94 inches. It is equipped with wheels and folds to 37 inches deep for convenient storage.

Setup Instructions

Carefully unpack all components and verify against the parts list in your manual. Assembly typically requires two people due to the size and weight of some components. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the included manual. Ensure all bolts and nuts are securely fastened, but do not overtighten. Pay close attention to the orientation of the nets during installation to ensure proper sensor function.

Operating Instructions

The Pop-A-Shot Home Dual Shot features an electronic scoring system with a control panel for game selection, volume adjustment, and audio options. To begin, ensure the unit is powered on (AC adapter or AA batteries). Use the 'Game' button to cycle through the 16 available game modes. Adjust the volume and select audio background using the respective buttons. Press 'Start' to begin playing. The infrared sensors accurately track baskets, and the large 3-digit scoreboard displays scores and time.

Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Pop-A-Shot game, regular maintenance is recommended. Keep the unit clean by wiping down surfaces with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals. Periodically check all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight. The steel frame is powder-coated to resist rust and chipping, but prolonged exposure to extreme weather conditions should be avoided. When not in use, especially for extended periods, fold the unit for storage to protect it from dust and damage.

Troubleshooting

- **Inaccurate Scoring:** If the sensors are not counting correctly, check the alignment of the nets. Ensure they are installed correctly and do not obstruct the infrared sensors located below the rims. Incorrect net installation is a common cause for scoring issues.
- **LCD Display Malfunction:** If the LCD display shows incomplete numbers or segments, contact customer support for assistance.
- **Balls Losing Air:** The included basketballs may require occasional reinflation. Use a standard ball pump with a needle to maintain proper air pressure.
- **Power Issues:** Ensure the AC adapter is securely plugged into both the unit and a working power outlet, or that fresh AA batteries are correctly installed.
