# Jata BQ95 Electric Barbecue Instruction Manual

Model: **BQ95** | Brand: **Jata**

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient use of your Jata BQ95 Electric Barbecue. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly, operation, and maintenance. Keep this manual for future reference.

### Important Safety Information

- Always ensure the appliance is unplugged before cleaning or assembly.
- Do not immerse the heating element or power cord in water or other liquids.
- This appliance is for household use only. Do not use outdoors or for commercial purposes.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Ensure the power supply matches the voltage specified on the appliance.
- Do not operate the barbecue if the cord or plug is damaged, or if the appliance malfunctions.
- Always place the barbecue on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- The surface of the appliance can become very hot during use. Avoid contact with hot surfaces.

## 2. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

---

The Jata BQ95 Electric Barbecue consists of the following main parts:

- Main Body with integrated heating element
- Stainless Steel Water Tray
- Grill Rack (with two adjustable height positions)
- Power Cord with plug

### **3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY**

---

The Jata BQ95 Electric Barbecue is designed for easy assembly and disassembly for cleaning. Follow these steps to set up your barbecue:

1. Place the main body of the barbecue on a stable, flat, and heat-resistant surface.
2. Insert the stainless steel water tray into the base of the main body. Ensure it is properly seated.
3. Position the heating element over the water tray. Make sure it is securely placed.
4. Place the grill rack onto the main body, resting it on the designated supports. The grill offers two height positions. Select the desired height by adjusting the grill supports.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps for optimal cooking results and to minimize smoke and odors:

1. **Fill Water Tray:** Before plugging in the appliance, fill the stainless steel water tray with water. This helps to reduce smoke and odors by catching dripping fats and keeps food from drying out. You may also add spices to the water for authentic flavor.
2. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
3. **Preheat:** Allow the barbecue to preheat for approximately 5-10 minutes until the heating element is glowing red.
4. **Place Food:** Carefully place your food (meat, fish, vegetables) onto the grill rack.
5. **Adjust Grill Height:** Utilize the two-level grill to select the appropriate cooking intensity. The higher position is suitable for slower cooking or keeping food warm, while the lower position provides more direct heat for faster grilling.
6. **Monitor Cooking:** Cook food to your desired doneness, turning as necessary.
7. **Disconnect Power:** After cooking, unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.

The 2000W power ensures efficient cooking for various types of food.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and hygienic operation of your Jata BQ95 Electric Barbecue. Always ensure the appliance is unplugged and completely cool before cleaning.

1. **Disassembly:** The barbecue is fully detachable for easy cleaning. Carefully remove the grill rack, heating element,

and water tray from the main body.

- Grill Rack and Water Tray:** These parts can be washed with warm soapy water. Use a non-abrasive sponge or brush to remove food residues. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely before reassembly.
- Heating Element and Main Body:** Wipe the heating element and the exterior of the main body with a lightly dampened cloth. Do not immerse the heating element or main body in water. Ensure no water enters the electrical components.
- Stubborn Stains:** For stubborn stains on the grill or tray, you may soak them in warm soapy water for a short period before cleaning.
- Storage:** Store the clean and dry barbecue in a cool, dry place.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Jata BQ95 Electric Barbecue, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not heat up.	Not plugged in, power outlet malfunction, damaged cord/plug.	Ensure the appliance is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the power cord for visible damage. If damaged, do not use and contact customer support.
Excessive smoke during cooking.	Water tray empty, too much fat dripping, food burning.	Ensure the water tray is filled with water before use. Trim excess fat from food. Adjust grill height if food is cooking too quickly or burning.
Food not cooking evenly.	Uneven food placement, grill not preheated sufficiently.	Ensure food is spread evenly on the grill. Allow the barbecue to preheat for the recommended time before placing food.
