IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Read all instructions thoroughly before operating the appliance. Adhere to basic safety precautions to minimize the risk of fire, electric shock, or personal injury.

- Ensure the dishwasher is properly grounded according to local electrical codes.
- Do not operate the appliance if the power cord is damaged. Contact qualified service personnel for repair.
- Keep children and pets away from the dishwasher during operation and when the door is open.
- Use only detergents and rinse agents specifically designed for automatic dishwashers. Using other products may cause excessive sudsing or damage.
- Do not touch the heating element during or immediately after the wash cycle. It can be extremely hot.
- Load sharp items (knives, skewers) with the handles up to reduce the risk of cuts.
- Never immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Danby DDW631SDB is a compact countertop dishwasher designed for efficient dishwashing in smaller living spaces. It features a stainless steel interior, electronic controls with an LED display, and multiple wash cycles to accommodate various dishwashing needs.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Unpacking and Inspection

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Inspect the dishwasher for any shipping damage. Report any damage to your retailer immediately. Ensure all accessories, including the quick connect adapter and hoses, are present.

Placement

Place the dishwasher on a flat, stable countertop surface near a sink with a faucet. Ensure there is adequate space around the unit for ventilation and door opening.

Water Connection

The dishwasher connects to most kitchen faucets using the supplied quick connect adapter. Ensure the faucet adapter is securely attached to your faucet and the quick connect hose is firmly connected to the adapter and the dishwasher's inlet.

Electrical Connection

Plug the dishwasher into a grounded 120 Volt, 60 Hz electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapter plugs. Ensure the electrical circuit is adequately rated for the appliance.

Adding Detergent and Rinse Aid

Add appropriate dishwasher detergent to the dispenser before each cycle. For improved drying performance and to prevent water spots, fill the rinse aid dispenser with a suitable rinse aid product.

Selecting a Wash Cycle

The DDW631SDB offers 8 wash programs to suit different cleaning needs, including Intensive, Normal, Economy, Rapid, Glass, Soak, Baby bottle, and Mini-Party.

Delay Start Option

Utilize the delay start feature to postpone the wash cycle by 2, 4, 6, or 8 hours, allowing you to run the dishwasher at a more convenient time.

Maintenance and Care

Cleaning the Filters

Regularly clean the filter system to ensure optimal washing performance and prevent blockages. The filter assembly is located at the bottom of the dishwasher tub.

Cleaning the Spray Arms

Check the spray arm nozzles periodically for any food particles or mineral deposits that might obstruct water flow. Clean them as needed to maintain effective spray patterns.

Cleaning the Interior and Exterior

Wipe down the interior and exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn stains, use a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Ensure the door seal is clean to prevent leaks.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, review the following common issues and their potential solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dishwasher does not start	Power cord not plugged in; Door not closed properly; Fuse blown or circuit breaker tripped.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Close the door firmly until it latches. Check household fuse/circuit breaker.
Dishes are not clean	Improper loading; Insufficient detergent; Clogged spray arm nozzles; Clogged filter.	Reload dishes correctly, avoiding overcrowding. Use recommended amount of detergent. Clean spray arm nozzles. Clean the filter system.
Water not draining	Drain hose kinked or blocked; Clogged filter; Sink drain blocked.	Check drain hose for kinks or obstructions. Clean the filter. Check if the sink drain is clear.
Excessive noise	Dishes rattling; Foreign object in pump; Unit not level.	Rearrange dishes to prevent contact. Inspect pump area for foreign objects. Ensure the dishwasher is level.
Water leaks	Door seal dirty or damaged; Hoses loose; Too much detergent.	Clean or replace door seal. Tighten hose connections. Use only recommended amount of detergent.
