## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the Transformers Studio Series 18 Deluxe Bumblebee action figure. This collectible figure converts between robot and Volkswagen Beetle modes, offering an engaging play and display experience for enthusiasts aged 8 and up.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

## SETUP

---

1. **Unboxing:** Carefully remove the figure and all accessories from the packaging. Retain the packaging if you wish to use the removable backdrop for display.
2. **Accessory Attachment:** Identify the included accessories. These typically include a blaster and an arm blade. Attach them to the designated ports on the figure's robot mode, usually on the arms or hands.
3. **Backdrop Setup:** If using the removable backdrop, carefully unfold it and position the figure in front of it for display.

## OPERATING: TRANSFORMATION

---

The Studio Series 18 Deluxe Bumblebee figure converts between robot mode and Volkswagen Beetle vehicle mode in 22 steps. Patience and careful handling are essential during transformation to prevent damage to the figure.

### Robot to Vehicle Mode (VW Beetle)

1. **Remove Accessories:** Detach any accessories from the figure.
2. **Fold Arms:** Carefully fold the robot's arms inward, tucking them against the body.
3. **Collapse Torso:** Compress the torso section, often involving rotating the waist and folding chest panels.
4. **Position Legs:** Straighten the legs and bring them together. The feet will often form part of the rear of the vehicle.
5. **Form Vehicle Shell:** Manipulate the panels from the back and sides of the robot to form the outer shell of the Volkswagen Beetle. This typically involves rotating the backpack section and aligning the car doors.
6. **Align Panels:** Ensure all panels snap securely into place to form a cohesive vehicle mode. Pay close attention to the alignment of the waist pivot joint and knee joints for proper locking.
7. **Final Adjustments:** Check for any gaps or misaligned parts and gently adjust them.

### Vehicle to Robot Mode

1. **Unlatch Panels:** Carefully unlatch the vehicle panels, starting from the rear or sides, to begin unfolding the robot components.
2. **Extend Legs:** Separate and extend the leg sections from the rear of the vehicle.
3. **Unfold Torso:** Unfold the chest and torso panels, rotating the waist as necessary to form the robot's upper body.
4. **Extend Arms:** Release and extend the arms from the side panels or undercarriage of the vehicle.
5. **Position Head:** Ensure the robot head is correctly positioned and facing forward.
6. **Attach Accessories:** Reattach the blaster and arm blade to the figure's hands or arm ports.

7. **Pose Figure:** Adjust the joints to pose Bumblebee in various action stances.

## MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to gently wipe dust from the figure. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the figure in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent discoloration or material degradation.
- **Handling:** Always handle the figure by its main body parts. Avoid excessive force on small or delicate components during transformation or posing.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Difficulty Transforming:** If the figure is difficult to transform, ensure all previous steps are completed correctly. Refer to online video guides if the printed instructions are unclear. Do not force parts.
- **Loose Joints:** Over time, some joints may become loose. For minor looseness, a small amount of clear nail polish

or a similar friction-enhancing liquid can be applied to the joint and allowed to dry completely.

- **Parts Not Aligning in Vehicle Mode:** Double-check that all panels are fully collapsed and tabbed into their correct positions. The waist pivot and knee joints are critical for proper alignment.
- **Accessories Not Staying Attached:** Ensure accessories are inserted firmly into the designated ports. If ports become loose, a small piece of tape or a thin layer of clear nail polish on the peg can improve grip.
