## INTRODUCTION

---

The Scott Shop Towels, Model 53693, are designed for various cleaning tasks, particularly those involving grease, liquids, and oils. These towels are engineered for strength, even when wet, making them suitable for demanding applications such as automotive maintenance and general workshop cleanup. Each roll features perforated sheets for easy dispensing.

## SETUP

---

Scott Shop Towels are ready for immediate use upon removal from packaging. No assembly or special preparation is required.

1. **Unpack the Roll:** Remove the plastic packaging from the roll of Scott Shop Towels.
2. **Place for Access:** Position the roll in a convenient location for your task, such as on a workbench, in a shop towel dispenser, or near the area where fluids are being handled.
3. **Identify Perforation:** Locate the perforated lines between each towel sheet. These lines are designed for easy tearing.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps for effective use of Scott Shop Towels:

1. **Dispense a Towel:** Pull a single towel from the roll, tearing along the perforation.
2. **Wipe Surfaces:** Use the towel to wipe up spills, clean tools, or absorb fluids. The towels are designed to be super strong and effective even when wet.
3. **Absorb Liquids:** For liquid spills, place the towel directly onto the spill to absorb. Multiple towels may be required for larger spills.
4. **Clean Grease and Oil:** The towels are particularly effective for cleaning grease and oil from surfaces and hands.

*Note:* These towels are intended for single-use applications, especially when dealing with hazardous or heavily soiled materials.

## MAINTENANCE AND DISPOSAL

---

Scott Shop Towels are disposable products and require no maintenance. Proper disposal is important after use.

- **Disposal:** After use, dispose of soiled towels in an appropriate waste receptacle.
- **Hazardous Waste:** If towels are used to clean up hazardous materials (e.g., certain chemicals, automotive fluids), dispose of them according to local regulations for hazardous waste.

- **Storage:** Store unused rolls in a dry environment to maintain their absorbency and integrity.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

While Scott Shop Towels are straightforward to use, here are solutions to common minor issues:

- **Towel Tears Unevenly:** Ensure you are tearing along the perforated line. A quick, firm pull perpendicular to the roll usually results in a clean tear.
- **Insufficient Absorbency:** For very large spills or highly viscous liquids, multiple towels may be required. Ensure the towel is making full contact with the liquid.
- **Towel Feels Weak When Wet:** While designed to be strong when wet, excessive saturation or aggressive scrubbing on rough surfaces can cause tearing. Use a fresh towel if the current one becomes too saturated.
