SETUP

The Hathaway Premium Domino Set requires minimal setup. Simply open the wooden carry case and remove the domino tiles. Ensure all 28 tiles are present before beginning play.

- Shuffling:** Place all dominoes face down and mix them thoroughly.
- Drawing Tiles:** Each player draws a set number of tiles (e.g., 7 for 2 players, 5 for 3-4 players).
- Starting the Game:** The player with the highest double (e.g., double-six) typically starts by placing it in the center.
- Playing Tiles:** Players take turns matching the pips on their tiles to the open ends of the dominoes already on the table.
- Drawing from Boneyard:** If a player cannot make a move, they must draw tiles from the remaining face-down dominoes (the
