OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your SBG7400AC2 is set up and activated, it will automatically begin providing internet service. The front panel LEDs indicate the status of your connection:

- Power: Solid green indicates the device is powered on.
- Receive/Send: Solid green indicates successful connection to the cable network. Blinking indicates data transfer.

- Online: Solid green indicates successful internet connection.
- 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi: Solid green indicates the 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi network is active.
- 5 GHz Wi-Fi: Solid green indicates the 5 GHz Wi-Fi network is active.
- WPS: Blinking when WPS pairing is active.

Manage your network, customize Wi-Fi settings, and implement parental controls using the **SURFboard Central App**. This app provides real-time monitoring of connected devices, allows setting time limits, and pausing internet access for specific devices.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your ARRIS SURFboard SBG7400AC2, consider the following maintenance tips:

- **Placement:** Place the modem in a central location, away from obstructions, other electronic devices, and heat sources to maximize Wi-Fi coverage and prevent overheating.
- Cleaning: Keep the device clean and dust-free. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the exterior. Do not use liquid cleaners.
- **Rebooting:** Periodically rebooting your modem (unplugging it for 30 seconds and plugging it back in) can resolve minor connectivity issues and improve performance.
- **Firmware Updates:** Firmware updates are typically managed automatically by your Internet Service Provider (ISP). Ensure your device is connected and powered on to receive these updates.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your ARRIS SURFboard SBG7400AC2, try the following common troubleshooting steps:

• No Internet Connection:

- Check all cable connections (coaxial, Ethernet, power) to ensure they are secure.
- Reboot the modem by unplugging it from the power outlet for 30 seconds, then plugging it back in. Wait for all indicator lights to stabilize.
- Verify that your ISP service is active and there are no local outages.

Slow Speeds:

- Ensure your devices are connected to the appropriate Wi-Fi band (5 GHz for faster speeds, 2.4 GHz for wider coverage).
- Minimize interference from other electronic devices (cordless phones, microwaves).
- Consider connecting critical devices directly via Ethernet for maximum speed.
- Check your ISP's advertised speeds and compare them with actual speeds using an online speed test.

• Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues:

- Ensure your Wi-Fi networks (2.4 GHz and 5 GHz) are enabled on the modem.
- Check your Wi-Fi password.
- If using the SURFboard Central App, ensure no parental controls or access restrictions are active.
