# Amazon Echo Dot (2nd Generation) User Manual

Model: Echo Dot (2. Generation)

## INTRODUCTION

The Amazon Echo Dot (2nd Generation) is a voice-controlled smart speaker that connects to the Alexa Voice Service. It is designed to provide hands-free assistance for various tasks, including playing music, making calls, setting alarms, answering questions, providing information, and controlling compatible smart home devices. Its compact design allows it to fit seamlessly into any room.

## SETUP

### 1. Unboxing and Power Connection

Carefully remove the Echo Dot and its accessories from the packaging. Connect the included EU power adapter to the

Echo Dot and then plug it into a wall outlet. The light ring on the Echo Dot will turn blue, then orange, indicating it is ready for setup.

## 2. Download the Alexa App

Download the Amazon Alexa app on your smartphone or tablet. The app is available for iOS and Android devices. Search for "Amazon Alexa" in your device's app store.

## 3. Connect to Wi-Fi

Open the Alexa app and follow the on-screen instructions to connect your Echo Dot to your Wi-Fi network. You will need your Wi-Fi network name and password. Ensure your smartphone is connected to the same Wi-Fi network you intend to use for the Echo Dot during setup.

## 4. Connect to External Speakers (Optional)

The Echo Dot can be connected to external speakers or headphones via Bluetooth or a 3.5mm stereo cable for enhanced audio output. To connect via Bluetooth, say "Alexa, pair" and follow the instructions in the Alexa app. For a wired connection, simply plug a 3.5mm audio cable from the Echo Dot's audio output jack to your speaker's input.

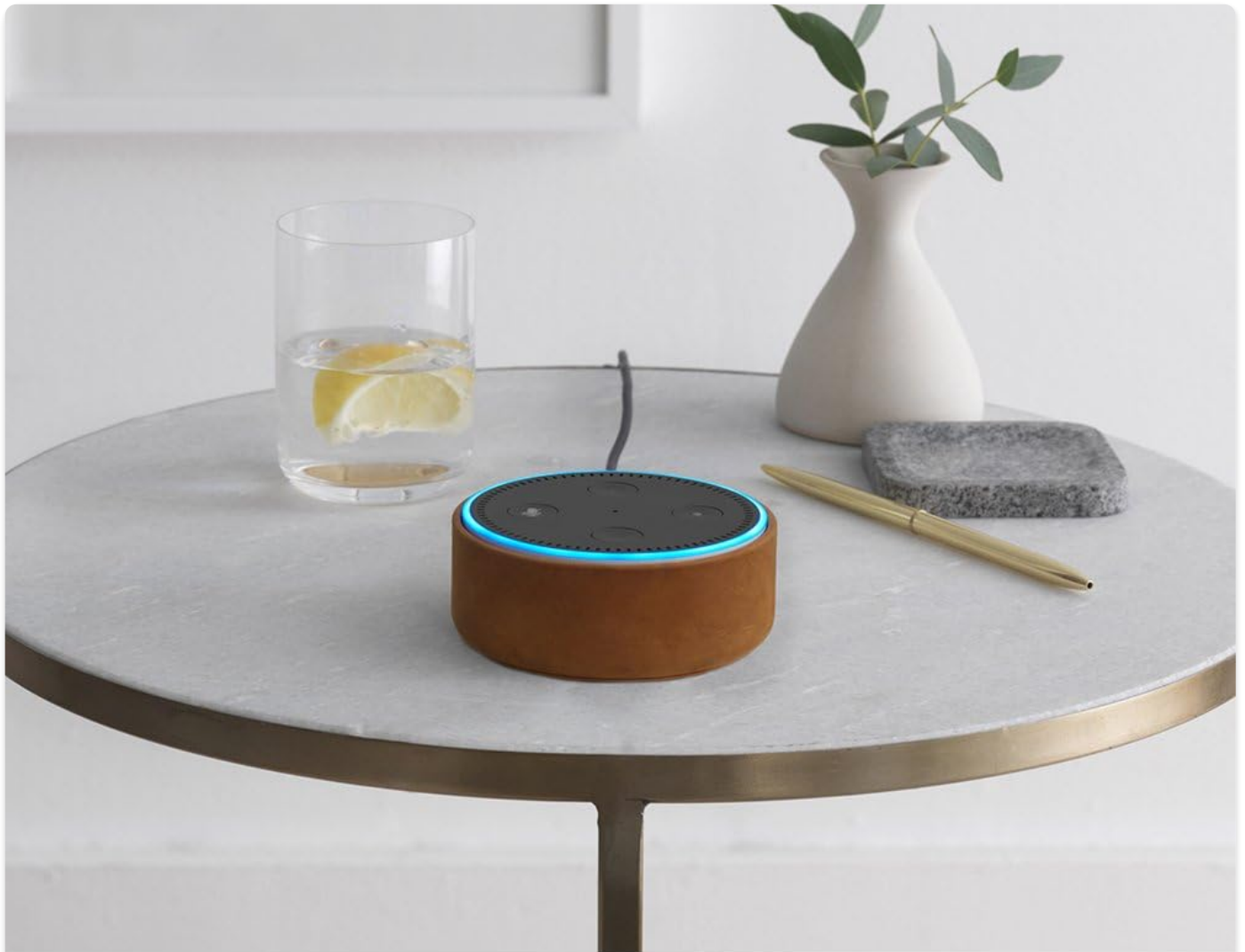
### OPERATING THE ECHO DOT

---

The Echo Dot is primarily operated using voice commands through the Alexa Voice Service. Simply say the wake word "Alexa" followed by your command or question.

#### Voice Control and Microphones

The Echo Dot features seven far-field microphones, allowing it to hear your voice commands from across the room, even in noisy environments or while music is playing. The light ring indicates when Alexa is listening or processing a request.



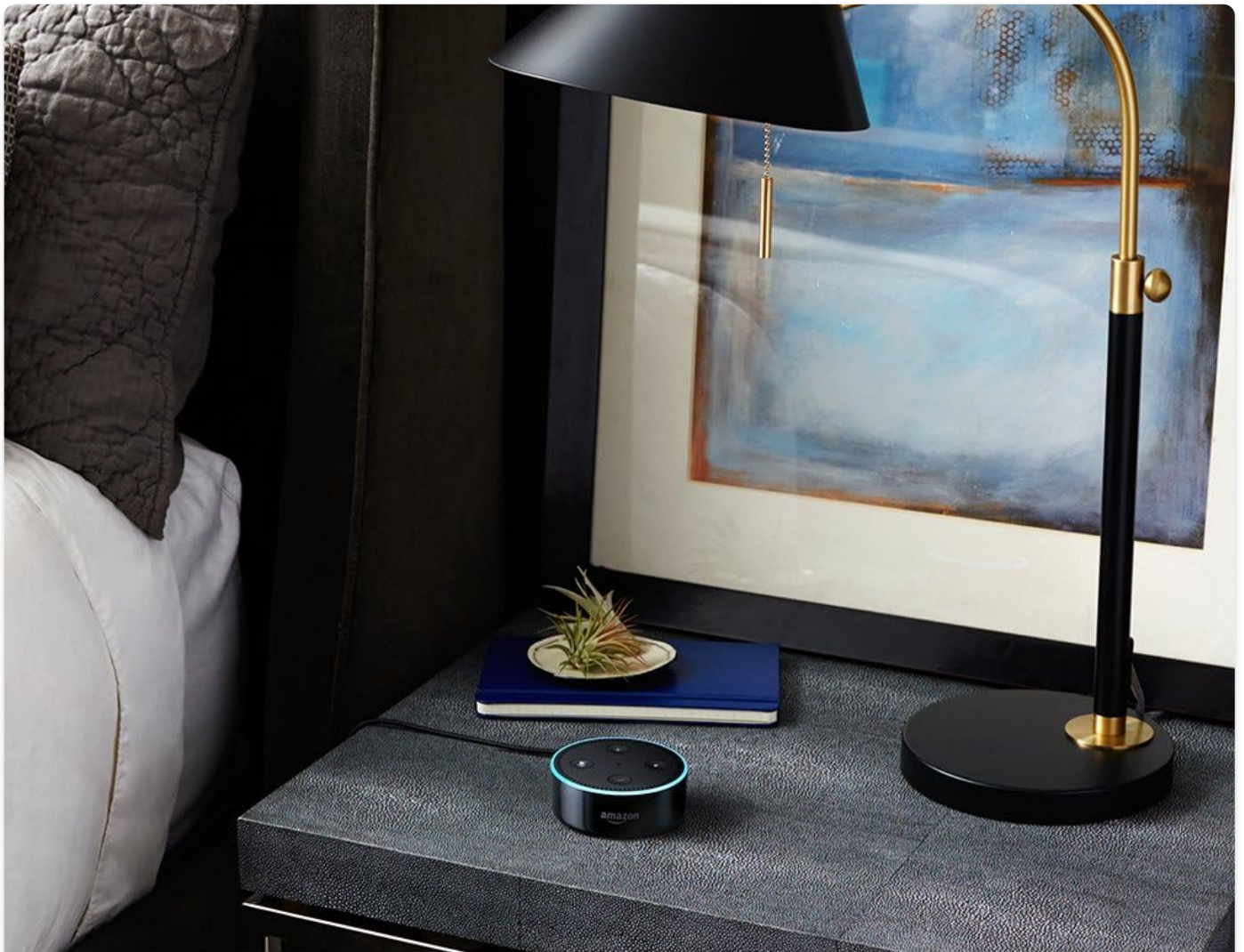
## Compact design makes it a convenient addition to any room

### Key Functions:

- **Music Playback:** Ask Alexa to play music from supported services like Amazon Music Unlimited (subscription required) and TuneIn. You can request specific songs, artists, genres, or playlists.
- **Calls and Messaging:** Make hands-free calls and send messages to other Echo devices or contacts via the Alexa app. You can also use the Drop In feature to connect quickly with other Echo devices in your home.
- **Information and Assistance:** Ask questions to get information, check the weather, set alarms and timers, manage to-do lists, and more.
- **Smart Home Control:** Control compatible smart home devices such as lights, plugs, switches, and thermostats using voice commands. Ensure your smart home devices are linked through the Alexa app.

### MAINTENANCE

---

#### Cleaning

To clean your Echo Dot, gently wipe the exterior with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Avoid getting moisture into any openings.

#### Software Updates

Your Echo Dot automatically receives software updates over Wi-Fi. Ensure your device is connected to the internet to

receive the latest features and security improvements.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Solution
Echo Dot is not responding.	Ensure the device is plugged in and the light ring is illuminated. Check if the microphone is muted (red light ring). Try saying "Alexa, stop" or "Alexa, cancel" if it's stuck on a command. Unplug the device for 30 seconds and plug it back in.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi.	Verify your Wi-Fi password. Ensure your router is working correctly. Move the Echo Dot closer to your router. Restart your router and the Echo Dot. Use the Alexa app to reconfigure Wi-Fi settings.
Audio quality is poor or no sound.	Adjust the volume using voice commands or the buttons on top of the device. If connected to external speakers, check their power and volume. Ensure the 3.5mm cable is fully inserted or Bluetooth connection is stable.
Alexa is not understanding commands.	Speak clearly and directly to the device. Reduce background noise. Ensure you are using the correct wake word ("Alexa"). Check your device's language setting in the Alexa app.

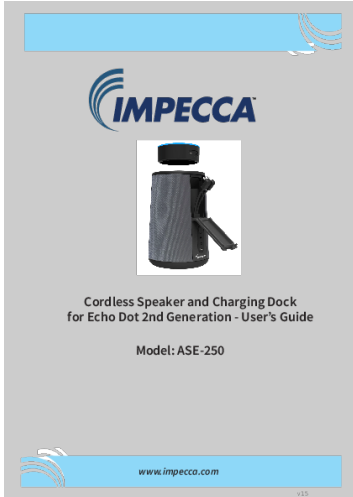

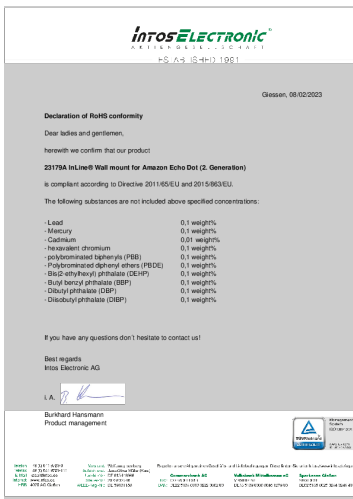

Bevor Sie Ihr Echo Dot und den Alexa Voice Service erstmalig verwenden, müssen Sie eine Verbindung mit einem WLAN-Netzwerk her und melden Sie das Gerät über die Alexa App bei Ihrem Amazon-Konto an. Führen Sie dazu die folgenden Schritte aus:

### 1. Laden Sie die Alexa App herunter und melden Sie sich an.

Mit der kostenlosen Alexa App können Sie Ihr Gerät einrichten und Wacker, Musik, Einkaufslisten und weitere Funktionen verwalten. Die Alexa App gibt es für Smartphones und Tablets mit:

- Fire OS 3.0 oder höher
- Android 4.4 oder höher
- iOS 8.0 oder höher

Um die Alexa App herunterzuladen, rufen Sie auf Ihrem Mobilgerät den AppStore auf und suchen Sie nach „Alexa App“. Wählen Sie die App aus und laden Sie sie herunter.

Alternativ können Sie auf einem Computer mit WLAN die Seite <http://alexa.amazon.de> in Safari, Chrome, Firefox, Microsoft Edge oder Internet Explorer (10 oder höher) aufrufen.

### 2. Schalten Sie den Echo Dot ein.

Platzieren Sie den Echo Dot an einem zentralen Ort (mit mindestens 20 cm Abstand von Wänden und Fenstern). Schließen Sie das mitgelieferte Netzkabel am Echo Dot an und stecken Sie den Stecker in eine Steckdose. Der Lichtring auf dem Echo Dot wird zuerst blau und danach orange. Wenn das Licht zu Orange wechselt, werden Sie von Alexa begrüßt.

**Anmerkung:** Über andere USB-Netzteile (wie Smartphone-Zubehör) erhält der Echo Dot möglicherweise zu wenig Strom.

### 3. Verbinden Sie den Echo Dot mit einem WLAN-Netzwerk.
