SETUP GUIDE

Charging the Speakers

Before first use, fully charge your Zulu Audio speakers.

- Locate the USB charging port on the speaker.
- Connect the provided USB charging cable to the speaker and a compatible USB power source.
- Charging time is approximately 4 hours for a full charge.

Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your speakers to a Bluetooth-enabled device:

- Ensure the speakers are powered on.
- Activate Bluetooth on your device (e.g., smartphone, tablet).
- Search for "Zulu Audio" or "Zulu Alpha 1201" in your device's Bluetooth settings.
- Select the speakers to pair. A confirmation sound or indicator light will confirm successful pairing.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off
