# Sony a7R III Mirrorless Camera Instruction Manual

Model: ILCE7RM3/B

# 1. Introduction

The Sony a7R III (Model: ILCE7RM3/B) is a high-resolution full-frame mirrorless digital camera designed for advanced photography and videography. It features a 42.4 MP back-illuminated Exmor R CMOS image sensor, capable of impressive shooting speeds up to 10 frames per second (fps) with full autofocus (AF) and auto-exposure (AE) tracking. This camera also delivers high-quality 4K HDR video, a wide 15-stop dynamic range, and high sensitivity with reduced noise. It is compatible with Sony E-mount lenses.

# 2. SETUP

#### 2.1. What's in the Box

## 2.2. Initial Setup

- 1. **Charge the Battery:** Use the supplied battery charger and AC adaptor to fully charge the rechargeable battery before first use.
- 2. **Insert Memory Card:** Open the memory card slot cover and insert compatible SD cards (UHS Speed Class 3 (U3) recommended for 4K video) into the designated slots. The camera supports two memory cards.
- 3. **Attach Lens:** Align the mounting index on the lens with the index on the camera body and rotate the lens clockwise until it clicks into place.
- 4. Attach Shoulder Strap: Securely attach the shoulder strap to the camera's strap lugs.

# 3. OPERATING THE CAMERA

#### 3.1. Camera Controls

The a7R III features intuitive controls for quick adjustments. Key controls include:

- **Mode Dial:** Located on the top plate, this dial allows selection of various shooting modes (AUTO, Programmed AE, Aperture Priority, Shutter-speed Priority, Manual, Movie modes).
- Exposure Compensation Dial: Adjusts exposure levels.
- AF-ON Button: Dedicated button for initiating autofocus.
- Fn (Function) Button: Provides quick access to frequently used settings.
- ISO Button: Adjusts ISO sensitivity.
- Custom Buttons (C1-C4): Customizable buttons for assigning preferred functions.

# 3.2. Display and Viewfinder

- **Tilting LCD Screen:** The 3-inch LCD screen can be tilted for comfortable shooting from various angles, including low-angle and overhead shots.
- **Electronic Viewfinder (EVF):** Provides a clear, real-time view of your scene with shooting information.



## 3.3. Autofocus System

The a7R III features a fast and accurate autofocus system with 399 phase-detection AF points and 425 contrast-detection AF points. Key AF features include:

- Eye AF: Advanced Eye AF for precise focus on human and animal eyes.
- AF Tracking: Reliable tracking of moving subjects.
- Focus Mode: Options include Automatic AF (AF-A), Single-shot AF (AF-S), Continuous AF (AF-C), Direct Manual Focus (DMF), and Manual Focus (MF).

## 3.4. Still Photography

- High Resolution: Capture detailed 42.4 MP images.
- Continuous Shooting: Up to 10 fps with AF/AE tracking.
- File Formats: Supports RAW and JPEG.
- Pixel Shift Multi Shooting: Combines multiple images for ultra-high resolution (requires external software).

## 3.5. Video Recording

The a7R III is capable of recording high-quality video:

- 4K HDR Video: Records 4K video with Hybrid Log-Gamma (HLG) for instant HDR workflow.
- Full HD Slow Motion: Records Full HD at up to 120 fps.
- Video Output: Micro-HDMI for external monitoring.

# 4. MAINTENANCE

# 4.1. Cleaning

- Camera Body: Wipe the camera body with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, use a slightly damp cloth and then dry thoroughly.
- Lens: Use a lens brush to remove dust, then gently wipe with a microfiber lens cloth. For smudges, use a lens cleaning solution applied to the cloth, not directly to the lens.
- **Sensor:** For sensor cleaning, it is recommended to use a professional service or a specialized sensor cleaning kit with extreme care.
- LCD Screen: Gently wipe with a soft, dry microfiber cloth.

## 4.2. Battery Care

- Store batteries in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- Avoid fully discharging batteries regularly to prolong their lifespan.
- Charge batteries fully before extended shooting sessions.

# 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Sony a7R III, consider the following common solutions:

- Camera does not turn on: Ensure the battery is fully charged and correctly inserted.
- **Images are blurry:** Check focus mode, ensure proper lens attachment, and verify shutter speed is appropriate for the scene.
- **Memory card error:** Reinsert the memory card, try a different card, or format the card (backing up data first).
- Video recording stops unexpectedly: Ensure you are using a high-speed memory card (UHS-I U3 or faster) and that the camera's internal temperature is not too high.
- **No sound in video:** Check microphone settings and ensure an external microphone (if used) is properly connected.


