1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing Oxelo Kids' Protective Gear. This set is designed to provide essential protection for children participating in rollerblading, skateboarding, and similar activities. It includes wrist guards, elbow pads, and knee pads, engineered for comfort and safety. Please read this manual carefully before use to ensure proper fit and maximum protection.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- 2 x Wrist Guards
- 2 x Elbow Pads
- 2 x Knee Pads

3. SETUP AND FITTING

Proper fitting is crucial for effective protection. Ensure each pad is securely fastened and covers the intended joint without restricting movement excessively.

3.1 Identifying Left and Right

Some pads are specifically designed for left or right limbs. Check the labels on the pads (e.g., 'LEFT' or 'RIGHT') to ensure correct placement.

3.2 Wearing Instructions

1. **Knee Pads:** Slide the knee pad onto the knee, ensuring the hard cap covers the kneecap. Secure

the straps firmly around the leg, above and below the knee.

2. **Elbow Pads:** Slide the elbow pad onto the elbow, positioning the hard cap over the elbow joint. Fasten the straps securely around the arm.
3. **Wrist Guards:** Place the wrist guard on the wrist, ensuring the splint (if present) is on the palm side. Secure the straps around the wrist and hand.

The pads are designed for easy wearing and removal. Adjust the straps to achieve a snug fit that does not slip during activity but also does not cut off circulation.

4. OPERATING (USAGE)

This protective gear is intended for use during activities such as rollerblading, skateboarding, scootering, and other similar sports where falls are possible. Always wear the full set of protective gear to minimize the risk of injury.

- Ensure all pads are correctly positioned and securely fastened before starting any activity.
- Regularly check the fit during activity, especially after falls or impacts.
- This gear is designed to absorb impact and reduce abrasions. It does not guarantee complete protection against all injuries.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your protective gear.

- **Cleaning:** Hand wash the pads with mild soap and cold water. Do not use harsh detergents or bleach.
- **Drying:** Air dry completely. Do not tumble dry or expose to direct heat, as this can damage the materials.
- **Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the pads for any signs of wear, tear, or damage to the stitching, straps, or hard caps. Replace damaged pads immediately.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your protective gear, consider the following:

- **Pads feel loose:** Re-adjust the straps to ensure a snug fit. If straps are worn out, consider replacing the set.
- **Discomfort during wear:** Ensure the pads are correctly oriented (left/right) and positioned on the joint. Adjust strap tension. If discomfort persists, the size might be incorrect.
- **Damage after impact:** Even if visible damage is minimal, the internal structure of the pad might be compromised. It is recommended to replace pads after a significant impact to ensure continued protection.



