1. INTRODUCTION

The Poly Plantronics Blackwire 3210 is a wired, monaural (single-ear) headset designed for unified communications (UC) environments. It features a boom microphone and connects via USB-A, making it compatible with PCs and Macs. This headset is part of the Blackwire 3200 series, known for its durability, comfort, and ease of deployment.

Key features include:

- Lightweight metal headband for durability and a comfortable fit.
- Intuitive inline controls for call answer/end, mute, and volume adjustment.
- PC wideband audio with noise-canceling microphone for high-quality PC telephony.
- Monaural design allows users to remain aware of their surroundings.

3. SETUP

3.1 Connecting Your Headset

1. Locate an available USB-A port on your PC or Mac.
2. Plug the USB-A connector of your Blackwire 3210 headset into the USB-A port.
3. Your computer should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers.

3.2 Wearing the Headset

- Place the earpiece over one ear. The monaural design allows you to keep one ear free to hear your surroundings.
- Adjust the headband for a comfortable and secure fit.
- Position the flexible boom microphone approximately two finger-widths from the corner of your mouth.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Inline Controls

The headset features intuitive inline controls for managing your calls and audio:

- **Call Answer/End Button:** Press to answer or end a call.
- **Volume Up/Down Buttons:** Press '+' to increase volume, '-' to decrease volume.
- **Mute Button:** Press to mute or unmute the microphone. A red indicator light on the control unit typically shows when muted.

4.2 Microphone Usage

The noise-canceling microphone ensures clear communication by reducing background noise.

- Adjust the boom arm so the microphone is positioned close to your mouth, about two finger-widths away.
- The flexible boom allows for precise positioning.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Blackwire 3210 headset, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Gently wipe the earpiece and headband with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a clean, dry place when not in use. Avoid extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- **Cable Care:** Do not pull on the cable to disconnect the headset. Always grasp the USB connector. Avoid sharp bends or kinks in the cable.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Blackwire 3210 headset, try the following steps:

- **No Audio/Microphone Not Working:**

- Ensure the USB-A connector is securely plugged into your computer.
- Check your computer's audio settings to ensure the headset is selected as the default input and output device.
- Verify that the microphone is not muted using the inline control.
- Try plugging the headset into a different USB port or another computer to rule out port or computer issues.

- **Poor Audio Quality:**

- Adjust the volume using the inline controls or your computer's settings.
- Ensure the microphone boom is properly positioned near your mouth.
- Check for any software updates for your operating system or the Plantronics Hub app.

- **Headset Not Recognized:**

- Restart your computer.
- Ensure the Plantronics Hub app is installed and updated.
