SETUP

Before installing the eyelets, gather the necessary tools and prepare your material.

Required Tools (Not Included):

- Hole punch tool (appropriate size for eyelet shank)
- Grommet setting tool (anvil and setter)
- Hammer or mallet
- Cutting mat or sturdy work surface

Material Preparation:

1. Identify the exact location where you want to install the eyelet on your fabric, leather, or other material.
2. Ensure the material is clean and free from debris.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS: EYELET INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to correctly install the antique brass eyelets:

1. Step 1: Punch a Hole

Place your material on a cutting mat or sturdy surface. Use a hole punch tool to create a clean hole in the material. The hole should be slightly smaller than the eyelet's outer barrel diameter to ensure a snug fit.

2. Step 2: Insert Eyelet

Insert the eyelet through the punched hole from the front side of your material. The flange (wider part) of the eyelet should rest flat against the front of the material.

3. Step 3: Place Washer

On the back side of the material, place a washer over the protruding barrel of the eyelet. The washer helps to secure the eyelet and provides a finished look.

4. Step 4: Set the Eyelet

Position the grommet setting tool (anvil underneath the eyelet flange, setter on top of the eyelet barrel). Strike the setter firmly with a hammer or mallet. This action will flare the eyelet barrel over the washer, securing it in place. Ensure the eyelet is fully crimped and secure.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your eyelets and the projects they are used in:

- Store unused eyelets and washers in a dry environment to prevent tarnishing or corrosion.
- Clean finished projects according to the care instructions of the base material. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the eyelet's finish.
- If the eyelets become dull over time, they can be gently polished with a soft cloth and a brass-appropriate cleaner, if desired.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Eyelet does not sit flush:

Ensure the hole punched in the material is the correct size. If the hole is too small, the eyelet may not pass through completely. If too large, the eyelet may be loose. Also, ensure the material is not too thick for the eyelet's barrel length.

Eyelet is loose after setting:

This usually indicates insufficient force was applied during setting, or the setting tool was not properly aligned. Re-align the setting tool and strike more firmly. Ensure the washer is correctly placed before setting.

Material tears around the eyelet:

The hole punched might be too large, or the material itself is too delicate for the application without reinforcement. Consider reinforcing the area with interfacing or a patch before installing the eyelet.
