## **NTRODUCTION**

This manual provides instructions for the proper installation and maintenance of the Crane Genuine Air Purifier Replacement Filter, Model HS-1944. This filter is specifically designed for use with the Crane Standard Air Purifier, Model EE-5067. Utilizing this genuine replacement filter ensures optimal performance of your air purifier, contributing to improved indoor air quality through its True HEPA filtration system.

# **SETUP: FILTER INSTALLATION**

Follow these steps to correctly install the Crane Genuine Air Purifier Replacement Filter (HS-1944) into your Crane Air Purifier (EE-5067).

- 1. **Power Off:** Ensure the air purifier is unplugged from the power outlet before beginning any installation or maintenance.
- Access Filter Compartment: Locate and open the filter compartment cover on your Crane Air Purifier Model EE-5067. Refer to your air purifier's main instruction manual for specific details on how to open this compartment.

- 4. **Prepare New Filter:** Unpack the new Crane Genuine Air Purifier Replacement Filter (HS-1944). Ensure all packaging materials are removed.
- 5. **Insert New Filter:** Place the new filter into the filter compartment. Ensure it is seated correctly and securely. The filter is designed for a specific fit.
- 6. Close Compartment: Close the filter compartment cover securely.

- 7. Restore Power: Plug the air purifier back into the power outlet.
- 8. **Reset Filter Indicator (if applicable):** If your air purifier has a filter replacement indicator light, consult your air purifier's manual for instructions on how to reset it after installing a new filter. This typically involves pressing and holding a specific button for a few seconds.

# **OPERATING WITH NEW FILTER**

Once the new filter is installed, your Crane Air Purifier Model EE-5067 is ready for operation. The HS-1944 filter features a 3-stage filtration system:

- Pre-Filter: Captures larger particles such as dust, pet dander, and lint.
- True HEPA Filter: Traps 99.97% of airborne particles as small as 0.3 microns, including pollen, mold spores, and dust mites.
- Activated Carbon Filter: Reduces common household odors from cooking, pets, and smoke.

# Maintenance: Filter Replacement Schedule

Regular replacement of the air filter is crucial for maintaining the efficiency and effectiveness of your Crane Air Purifier. The recommended replacement timeline for the HS-1944 filter is every **3 to 6 months**. This duration can vary based on:

- Usage Frequency: Continuous operation will require more frequent replacement.
- Air Quality: Environments with higher levels of pollutants, allergens, or pet dander may necessitate earlier replacement.
- Indicator Light: Pay attention to your air purifier's filter replacement indicator, if equipped.

Failure to replace the filter regularly can lead to decreased air purification performance and potentially reduce the lifespan of your air purifier.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If you encounter issues after replacing your filter, consider the following:

- Filter Not Fitting: Ensure you have the correct replacement filter (Model HS-1944) for your Crane Air Purifier (Model EE-5067). Double-check the orientation of the filter during installation.
- Air Purifier Not Turning On: Verify that the air purifier is properly plugged into a working power outlet. Ensure the filter compartment cover is fully closed and secured, as some units have safety interlocks.
- **Decreased Airflow or Performance:** Confirm the new filter is installed correctly and not obstructed. If the issue persists, the air purifier itself may require troubleshooting; refer to its main manual.
- Filter Indicator Light Remains On: If your air purifier has a filter reset function, ensure you have performed the reset procedure as outlined in your air purifier's main instruction manual.
