For Compact Power Cyclonic Vacuum Cleaners (e.g., RO3753EA)

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Rowenta Dust Container, model RS-RT900590. This dust container is designed as a replacement or spare part for Rowenta Compact Power Cyclonic vacuum cleaners, such as the RO3753EA model. Please read these instructions carefully before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your product.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Before installing the new dust container, ensure your vacuum cleaner is unplugged from the power outlet. This prevents accidental activation and ensures safety during the installation process.

- 1. Remove the old dust container:** Locate the release mechanism on your Rowenta Compact Power Cyclonic vacuum cleaner, typically a button or latch. Press or unlatch it to detach the existing dust container.
- 2. Inspect the vacuum cleaner's housing:** Before inserting the new container, check the vacuum cleaner's dust container housing for any debris or obstructions that might prevent a secure fit. Clean if necessary.
- 3. Insert the new dust container:** Align the new Rowenta Dust Container (RS-RT900590) with the opening on your vacuum cleaner. Gently push it into place until you hear a click, indicating it is securely locked. Ensure there are no gaps between the container and the vacuum body.
- 4. Verify secure attachment:** Lightly pull on the container to confirm it is firmly attached and will not detach during operation.

OPERATION: EMPTYING THE DUST CONTAINER

Regularly emptying the dust container is crucial for maintaining optimal suction power and preventing blockages. The Rowenta Compact Power Cyclonic dust container features a "Clean Express" system for hygienic emptying.

1. **Remove the dust container:** Ensure the vacuum cleaner is unplugged. Press the release button or latch to detach the dust container from the vacuum body.

2. **Position over a waste bin:** Hold the dust container over a waste bin to prevent dust from scattering.
3. **Activate Clean Express (Step 1):** Locate the "Clean Express" mechanism on the lid of the dust container. This is usually a lever or button. Follow the first indicated step (often labeled '1') to open the bottom flap of the container.
4. **Empty contents:** Allow all accumulated dust and debris to fall into the waste bin. Gently shake the container if necessary to dislodge stubborn particles.
5. **Close the flap (Step 2):** Once empty, close the bottom flap securely, following the second indicated step (often labeled '2') on the "Clean Express" mechanism, until it clicks into place.
6. **Reattach to vacuum:** Reinstall the empty dust container onto the vacuum cleaner as described in the "Setup and Installation" section.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning of the dust container and its internal filter components is essential for maintaining the vacuum cleaner's performance and extending the life of the dust container.

- 1. Disassemble the container:** After emptying, you may need to further disassemble the dust container to access the internal filter. Refer to your vacuum cleaner's main manual for specific instructions on detaching the filter from the container. The Rowenta Compact Power Cyclonic series often uses a HEPA filter.
- 2. Clean the dust container:** Wash the plastic parts of the dust container with lukewarm water and a mild detergent. Ensure all dust and debris are removed. Rinse thoroughly.
- 3. Clean the filter:** If your filter is washable (check your vacuum's main manual), rinse it under running water until the water runs clear. Do not use detergent on the filter unless specifically instructed. If the filter is not washable, tap it gently over a bin to remove dust. Replace non-washable filters regularly as recommended by Rowenta.
- 4. Dry thoroughly:** Allow all components, especially the filter, to air dry completely for at least 24 hours before reassembling. Reassembling wet components can damage the vacuum cleaner and promote mold growth.
- 5. Reassemble:** Once completely dry, reassemble the filter into the dust container and then reattach the container to the vacuum cleaner.

Note: The frequency of cleaning depends on usage. For heavy use or pet hair, more frequent cleaning is recommended.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues related to the dust container. For vacuum cleaner specific issues, refer to your main vacuum cleaner manual.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dust container not fitting securely.	Incorrect alignment; debris in housing; damaged latch.	Ensure correct alignment. Check for and remove any debris. If latch is damaged, contact Rowenta support.
Reduced suction power.	Dust container is full; filter is clogged; container not sealed properly.	Empty the dust container. Clean or replace the filter. Ensure the container is securely attached and sealed.
Dust escaping from the container.	Container not closed properly; seal is damaged; container is overfilled.	Ensure the "Clean Express" flap is fully closed. Check the rubber seals for damage and replace if necessary. Do not overfill the container.
