Marantz ND8006 Digital Media Player User Manual

Model: ND8006

1. Introduction

The Marantz ND8006 is a versatile digital media player designed to integrate various audio sources into a single unit. It functions as a CD player, network music streamer, digital-to-analog converter (DAC), and preamplifier. This device supports playback from physical CDs, local USB storage, and online services including streaming platforms and Internet radio. It incorporates HEOS multi-room audio technology, Apple AirPlay, and Bluetooth connectivity.

The ND8006 features Marantz's unique Musical Digital Filtering (MMDF) technology, audiophile-grade DACs, and HDAM (Hyper Dynamic Amplifier Module) circuitry to ensure precise handling of digital audio signals, resulting in high-resolution sound reproduction. It also includes a dedicated headphone amplifier with HDAM-SA2 and gain control. The unit can connect directly to powered speakers or a power amplifier via its variable level output, allowing it to serve as a multi-source digital player and pre-amplifier.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking and Placement

Carefully remove the ND8006 from its packaging. Place the unit on a stable, level surface with adequate ventilation to prevent overheating. Avoid placing it near heat sources or in direct sunlight.

3.2 Connecting Antennas

Attach the two supplied wireless antennas to the antenna terminals on the rear panel of the ND8006. Ensure they are securely tightened and positioned vertically for optimal Wi-Fi and Bluetooth reception.

3.3 Power Connection

Connect the supplied power cord to the AC inlet on the rear of the ND8006, then plug the other end into a suitable wall outlet. Ensure the unit's power switch is in the OFF position before connecting.

3.4 Audio Connections

The ND8006 offers various output options:

- Analog Output (Fixed/Variable): Connect to an amplifier's analog input using RCA cables. Use the
 fixed output for an amplifier with its own volume control, or the variable output if using the ND8006 as a
 pre-amplifier directly to a power amplifier or powered speakers.
- **Digital Outputs (Optical/Coaxial):** Connect to a separate DAC or digital input on an amplifier using an optical or coaxial digital cable.

For digital audio inputs, the ND8006 includes optical and coaxial digital inputs, as well as a USB-B input for connecting to a computer and a front USB-A port for USB storage devices.

3.5 Network Connection

The ND8006 can connect to your home network via wired Ethernet or Wi-Fi.

- Wired Connection: Connect an Ethernet cable from your router to the LAN port on the rear of the ND8006.
- Wireless Connection: After powering on, navigate to the network settings menu on the unit's display to connect to your Wi-Fi network. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your network and enter the password.

3.6 Remote Control Setup

Insert the two supplied AA batteries into the remote control, ensuring correct polarity. The remote can control both the ND8006 and compatible Marantz amplifiers.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Operation

- Power On/Off: Press the power button on the front panel or the remote control.
- Input Selection: Use the 'INPUT' button on the front panel or the remote to cycle through available sources (CD, Network, USB-A, USB-B, Optical, Coaxial, Bluetooth).
- **Volume Control:** If using the ND8006 in variable output mode (as a pre-amplifier), adjust the 'LEVEL' knob on the front panel or the volume buttons on the remote.

4.2 CD Playback

Insert a CD into the disc tray. The unit will automatically switch to CD input and begin playback. Use the play, pause, stop, skip, and search buttons on the front panel or remote control.

4.3 USB Playback

Connect a USB storage device (e.g., USB flash drive, external hard drive) to the front USB-A port. Select 'USB-A' as the input. Use the navigation buttons on the unit or remote to browse and select audio files for playback.

4.4 Network Streaming (HEOS, AirPlay, Internet Radio)

Ensure the ND8006 is connected to your network. Download the HEOS app on your smartphone or tablet for comprehensive control over network features, including:

- **HEOS:** Access music streaming services (Spotify, Tidal, Amazon Music, etc.), Internet radio, and music files stored on your local network (NAS, PC). The HEOS app allows multi-room audio synchronization with other HEOS-enabled devices.
- AirPlay 2: Stream audio wirelessly from Apple devices (iPhone, iPad, Mac) to the ND8006.

 Internet Radio: Browse and play thousands of Internet radio stations via the HEOS app or the unit's menu.

4.5 Bluetooth Connectivity

Select 'Bluetooth' as the input. On your mobile device, enable Bluetooth and select 'Marantz ND8006' from the list of available devices to pair. Once paired, you can stream audio from your device to the ND8006.

4.6 DAC Functionality (USB-B Input)

Connect your computer to the ND8006's rear USB-B input using a USB cable. Install any necessary drivers (available on the Marantz website) on your computer. Select 'USB-B' as the input on the ND8006 to use it as an external DAC for your computer's audio output.

4.7 Headphone Output

Plug headphones into the 6.3mm (1/4 inch) headphone jack on the front panel. Adjust the 'PHONES LEVEL' knob to control headphone volume independently.

4.8 Voice Control (Amazon Alexa)

The ND8006 is compatible with Amazon Alexa. To enable voice control, link your HEOS account with your Alexa account through the Alexa app. You can then use voice commands to control playback, volume, and input selection.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

To clean the unit, wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn marks, use a slightly damp cloth with a mild, non-abrasive cleaner, then wipe dry. Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the finish.

5.2 Disc Tray Care

Keep the disc tray clean and free of dust. Avoid touching the lens inside the disc tray. If the tray becomes dirty, use a soft, dry cloth to gently clean it.

5.3 Firmware Updates

The ND8006 supports automatic firmware updates via its internet connection. Ensure the unit is connected to the internet to receive the latest software improvements and features. You can check for updates manually through the unit's setup menu.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Marantz ND8006, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not connected; Power outlet faulty	Ensure power cord is securely connected; Try a different power outlet.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound output	Incorrect input selected; Amplifier not powered on; Cables loose; Mute activated	Select correct input source; Power on amplifier; Check all audio cable connections; Deactivate mute function.
CD does not play	Disc inserted incorrectly; Disc dirty or scratched; Disc format not supported	Insert disc correctly (label side up); Clean or replace disc; Ensure disc is a standard audio CD.
Network connection issues	Wi-Fi password incorrect; Router issues; Antennas not connected	Verify Wi-Fi password; Restart router; Ensure antennas are securely attached.
Remote control not working	Batteries depleted or inserted incorrectly; Obstruction between remote and unit	Replace batteries, ensuring correct polarity; Remove any obstructions; Ensure remote is pointed at the unit's IR sensor.
