## INTRODUCTION

---

Welcome to the MasterChef Planetary Mixer BA1001V/02 instruction manual. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your new planetary mixer. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain for future reference.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

---

### General Safety

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not immerse the motor unit, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning.
- Avoid contact with moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- Keep hands and utensils away from the bowl during operation to reduce the risk of severe injury to persons or damage to the mixer.
- Never add ingredients while the appliance is running.
- Ensure the mixer is switched off and unplugged before changing accessories.
- This appliance is intended for household use only.

### Electrical Safety

- Ensure the voltage rating on the appliance matches your local power supply (220V).
- Do not use with an extension cord unless it has been tested and approved for use with this appliance.

## PRODUCT COMPONENTS

### Included Accessories

Your MasterChef Planetary Mixer BA1001V/02 comes with 5 essential accessories:

- **Whisk:** Ideal for whipping eggs, cream, and light batters.
- **Flat Beater:** Suitable for mixing medium batters, such as cakes, cookies, and frostings.
- **Dough Hook:** Designed for kneading heavy doughs like bread and pizza.
- **4.3 Liter Stainless Steel Bowl:** A durable and spacious bowl for all your mixing needs.
- **Anti-Splash Lid:** Prevents ingredients from splashing out of the bowl during operation.

## SETUP AND FIRST USE

---

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the stainless steel bowl, whisk, flat beater, dough hook, and anti-splash lid in warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the motor unit with a damp cloth.
3. **Placement:** Place the mixer on a clean, dry, flat, and stable surface. Ensure there is adequate space around the mixer for ventilation and operation. The non-slip feet will help secure the unit.
4. **Attaching the Bowl:** Place the 4.3-liter stainless steel bowl onto the base and turn it clockwise until it locks securely into place.
5. **Attaching an Accessory:**
  - a. Ensure the mixer is unplugged and the speed control is set to 'OFF'.
  - b. Press the head release lever to tilt the motor head upwards.
  - c. Insert the desired accessory (whisk, flat beater, or dough hook) into the attachment shaft. Push upwards and turn clockwise until it locks into place.
  - d. Lower the motor head until it clicks into its locked position.
6. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a 220V electrical outlet.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps for safe and effective operation of your planetary mixer:

1. **Adding Ingredients:** With the motor head lowered and an accessory attached, add your ingredients to the stainless steel bowl. You may use the anti-splash lid to cover the bowl, adding ingredients through its opening if desired.
2. **Selecting Speed:** Turn the speed control dial to the desired setting. The mixer offers 8 speed options, allowing for precise control over various mixing tasks. Start with a low speed and gradually increase as needed to prevent splashing.
3. **Mixing:** Allow the mixer to operate until your ingredients are thoroughly combined or whipped to the desired consistency. The planetary action ensures even mixing throughout the bowl.
4. **Stopping Operation:** Turn the speed control dial back to the 'OFF' position.
5. **Removing Accessory and Bowl:**
  - a. Unplug the mixer from the power outlet.
  - b. Press the head release lever to tilt the motor head upwards.
  - c. Remove the accessory by turning it counter-clockwise and pulling downwards.
  - d. Unlock the stainless steel bowl by turning it counter-clockwise and lifting it off the base.

### Recommended Speed Settings:

- **Speeds 1-2:** For kneading heavy doughs (e.g., bread, pizza) with the dough hook.
- **Speeds 3-5:** For mixing medium batters (e.g., cakes, cookies, frostings) with the flat beater.
- **Speeds 6-8:** For whipping light mixtures (e.g., egg whites, cream) with the whisk.

## MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your MasterChef Planetary Mixer.

- 1. Always Unplug:** Before cleaning, always ensure the mixer is unplugged from the power outlet and has cooled down.
- 2. Cleaning Accessories and Bowl:** The stainless steel bowl, whisk, flat beater, dough hook, and anti-splash lid are dishwasher safe or can be washed by hand in warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry immediately to prevent water spots or corrosion.
- 3. Cleaning the Motor Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the motor unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals. Never immerse the motor unit in water or any other liquid.
- 4. Storage:** Store the mixer and its accessories in a clean, dry place. Ensure the power cord is neatly wrapped and not kinked.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter any issues with your MasterChef Planetary Mixer, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mixer does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet not working; motor head not fully lowered and locked.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working 220V outlet. Check if the motor head is fully lowered and locked into position.
Accessory not attaching or detaching easily.	Accessory not aligned correctly; debris in the attachment shaft.	Ensure the accessory is aligned with the shaft and pushed upwards before turning. Check for any obstructions in the shaft.
Mixer head does not stay down or is difficult to lift.	Head release lever mechanism issue.	Ensure the head release lever is fully engaged or disengaged. If the issue persists, contact customer support. Avoid forcing the mechanism.
Excessive noise or vibration during operation.	Mixer not on a stable surface; bowl or accessory not properly secured; overloading.	Place the mixer on a flat, stable surface. Ensure the bowl and accessory are securely locked. Do not exceed the recommended capacity for ingredients.
Ingredients not mixing evenly.	Incorrect accessory used for the mixture; too much or too little liquid.	Refer to the "Recommended Speed Settings" for appropriate accessory use. Adjust ingredient quantities as per recipe.
