# BenQ HT2550 4K UHD HDR Home Theater Projector Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your BenQ HT2550 4K UHD HDR Home Theater Projector. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the projector to ensure optimal performance and safety.

### Key Features:

- **True 4K UHD Resolution:** 8.3 million distinct pixels for stunning clarity.

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Physical Placement

The BenQ HT2550 features a compact design with 1.2x zoom and Auto vertical Keystone, allowing for flexible placement. Consider the throw ratio (1.47 - 1.76) to determine the optimal distance from the screen for your desired image size (60" to 200").

### 3.2 Connecting Devices

The projector offers various connectivity options:

- **HDMI:** 2 ports (HDMI 1: 2.0 / HDCP 2.2; HDMI 2: 1.4a / HDCP 1.4) for connecting Blu-ray players, gaming consoles, or streaming devices.
- **USB Type A:** 1 port (2.0/Power Supply) for media playback or powering accessories.
- **USB (Type mini B):** 1 port.
- **PC (D-Sub):** 1 port for computer connection.
- **Audio In/Out (3.5mm Mini Jack):** 1 each for external audio devices.
- **RS232 (DB-9pin):** 1 port for control systems.
- **DC 12V Trigger (3.5mm Jack):** 1 port for synchronized screen control.

### 3.3 Initial Power On and Adjustment

1. Connect the power cord to the projector and a power outlet.
2. Press the power button on the projector or remote control.
3. Adjust the focus and zoom using the rings on the lens.
4. Utilize the vertical keystone adjustment ( $\pm 40$  degrees) to correct image distortion if the projector is not perfectly perpendicular to the screen.

## 4. OPERATING THE PROJECTOR

### 4.1 Picture Modes

The BenQ HT2550 offers several picture modes to optimize viewing for different content:

- **ISF Disabled:** Bright / Vivid / Cinema / Sport / User 1 / User 2
- **ISF Enabled:** Bright / Vivid / Cinema / Sport / User 1 / User 2 / ISF Night / ISF Day

Select the appropriate mode via the projector's menu or remote control for the best visual experience.

### 4.2 HDR and 3D Content

The projector supports HDR (High Dynamic Range) for enhanced contrast and color. It also features 3D compatibility with various formats:

- **Frame Sequential:** Up to 1280x720 120Hz
- **Frame Packing:** Up to 1080p 24Hz
- **Top Bottom:** Up to 720p 60Hz

Ensure your content source and 3D glasses (if applicable) are compatible with these formats.

### 4.3 Audio Output

The projector includes a built-in 5W speaker. For a more immersive audio experience, connect external speakers via the 3.5mm Audio out jack or through your HDMI receiver.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Lamp Life

The projector's lamp has an estimated lifespan depending on the usage mode:

- **Normal Mode:** 4000 hours
- **Economic Mode:** 10000 hours
- **SmartEco Mode:** 8000 hours
- **LampSave Mode:** 15000 hours

Regular cleaning of the lens and ensuring proper ventilation will help prolong the lamp's life and maintain image quality.

### 5.2 Firmware Updates

BenQ periodically releases firmware updates to improve performance and address issues. As of March 16, 2018, units include Firmware Update 1.0.3. For information on checking your current firmware version or obtaining updates, please refer to the official BenQ support resources.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

### Common Issues and Solutions:

- **No Image/Signal:** Ensure all cables (HDMI, PC) are securely connected and the correct input source is selected on the projector. Verify the source device is powered on and outputting a signal.
- **Image Distortion:** Use the keystone adjustment to correct trapezoidal images. Ensure the projector is placed on a stable, level surface.
- **Fuzzy/Unclear Image:** Adjust the focus ring on the lens until the image is sharp. Ensure the lens is clean.
- **Projector Noise:** A faint fan noise is normal. Check if the projector is in "Silence" mode (if available) which might limit resolution. Ensure adequate ventilation to prevent overheating, which can increase fan speed.
- **Light Border Around Image:** This can occur with some projectors. Ensure your screen has a black velvet border or consider LED backlighting around the screen to minimize its visibility.
