


Figure 2: Mandolin Headstock with Chrome Tuners

Your Donner A Style Mandolin DML-1 comes with essential accessories to get you started. Please follow these steps for initial setup:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the mandolin and all accessories from the packaging. The bundle includes a gig bag, extra strings, a digital clip-on tuner, a polishing cloth, and guitar picks.
2. **Bridge Placement:** The mandolin bridge is often shipped unattached to prevent damage. Locate the bridge and carefully place it on the mandolin's top, aligning it with the f-holes and string paths. The bridge should be positioned so that the strings are roughly centered over the fretboard.
3. **Stringing:** Your mandolin may come with strings already installed, but it's good practice to check their condition. If new strings are needed or if the bridge was unattached, carefully install the strings, ensuring they are properly seated in the tailpiece and wound around the tuning pegs. Refer to online resources or a professional for detailed stringing instructions if unsure.
4. **Tuning:** Use the included digital clip-on tuner. Attach it to the headstock of the mandolin. Pluck each string pair individually and adjust the corresponding tuning peg until the tuner indicates the correct pitch. Mandolins are typically tuned in fifths: G-G-D-D-A-A-E-E (from lowest to highest pitch). New strings may stretch and require frequent re-tuning initially.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your mandolin is set up and tuned, you can begin to explore playing it:

1. **Holding the Mandolin:** Sit comfortably with the mandolin resting on your lap. The body should be against your torso, and the neck should extend away from you at a slight upward angle. Use a strap for standing play.
2. **Picking Technique:** Hold a guitar pick (one is included in your bundle) between your thumb and index finger. Use a downward and upward motion to strike the string pairs. Experiment with different pick angles and pressure to find your preferred tone.
3. **Fretting:** Use the fingers of your non-picking hand to press down on the strings just behind the frets. Ensure firm pressure to produce clear notes without buzzing.
4. **Basic Chords and Scales:** Begin by learning simple chords and scales. Numerous online resources and

instructional books are available to guide you through basic mandolin playing.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and maintain the sound quality of your mandolin:

- **Cleaning:** After each use, wipe down the strings, fretboard, and body with the included polishing cloth to remove oils and sweat. This prevents grime buildup and corrosion.
- **String Replacement:** Strings should be replaced regularly, typically every few months or when they sound dull or show signs of wear. Use the extra set of alloy steel strings provided or purchase new ones of similar gauge.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store your mandolin in its gig bag to protect it from dust, humidity changes, and accidental damage. Avoid extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- **Bridge Adjustment:** Periodically check the bridge position and height. Adjust as needed to maintain optimal string action and intonation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their solutions:

- **Tuning Instability:** New strings often stretch and require frequent re-tuning. Ensure strings are properly wound around tuning pegs. Check if tuning pegs are loose; tighten screws if necessary.
- **Buzzing Strings:** This can be caused by low string action (strings too close to the fretboard), uneven frets, or improper fretting technique. Adjust the bridge height or consult a luthier if the issue persists.
- **Dull Sound:** Old or dirty strings can produce a dull sound. Replace strings regularly and keep them clean.
- **Difficulty Playing:** High string action can make the mandolin harder to play. Adjust the bridge height to lower the action to a comfortable level.
