INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and proper use, assembly, and maintenance of your Hauck Sport Stroller. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always ensure the safety of your child by adhering to the following guidelines:

- Always use the **5-point safety belt** to secure your child in the stroller.
- Ensure the **bumper bar** is properly attached before use.
- Never leave your child unattended in the stroller.
- Do not overload the storage basket. The maximum weight capacity for the basket is 5.9 pounds (2.6 kg).
- The stroller is designed for infants. Do not exceed the maximum weight recommendation of 15 kilograms (approximately 33 pounds).
- Always engage the wheel brakes when the stroller is stationary.
- Keep fingers clear of moving parts when folding or unfolding the stroller.

- Ensure the stroller is fully open and locked before placing a child inside.
- The canopy provides sun protection; however, do not expose your child to direct sunlight for extended periods.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Your Hauck Sport Stroller comes mostly pre-assembled. Follow these steps for initial setup:

1. Unfolding the Stroller:

Release the folding latch (if engaged). Hold the handle and lift upwards until the frame clicks into place, indicating it is fully open and locked. Ensure all locking mechanisms are secure before use.

2. Attaching Wheels:

If wheels are not pre-attached, push each wheel onto its axle until it clicks securely into place. Pull gently on the wheel to ensure it is firmly attached.

3. Attaching the Bumper Bar:

Align the bumper bar with the attachment points on the stroller frame and push until it clicks into place on

both sides.

4. Adjusting the Canopy:

Extend the canopy by pulling it forward to provide shade for your child.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Folding the Stroller

To fold the Hauck Sport Stroller for storage or transport:

1. Ensure the canopy is fully retracted.
2. Locate the folding mechanism (usually a lever or button near the handle or on the side of the frame).
3. Engage the mechanism and push the handle forward and down, allowing the stroller to collapse.
4. Secure the folding latch to keep the stroller in its compact folded position.

Adjusting the Backrest and Leg Rest

- **Backrest:** To recline the backrest, locate the adjustment strap or lever behind the seat. Loosen the strap or press the lever to adjust to the desired position. To raise, pull the strap upwards.
- **Leg Rest:** The leg rest can be adjusted by pressing the buttons on either side of the leg rest and moving it up or down to the desired angle.



COMFORTABLE AND SAFE

Whether sitting or lying down, your child will be comfortable in the Sport Buggy with its easily adjustable backrest and footrest. The canopy protects them from wind and weather while you both enjoy the views. A 5-point harness ensures that they cannot climb or fall out and the brake means the buggy is always secure – even in a moving bus.

Using the Wheel Locks

The front wheels can be locked for stability on uneven terrain or when navigating straight paths. To lock, push the lever on each front wheel down. To unlock, pull the lever up. Always engage the rear wheel brakes when the stroller is stationary.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Spot clean fabric components with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh detergents or abrasive cleaners.
- **Frame:** Wipe the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Dry thoroughly to prevent rust.
- **Wheels:** Regularly check wheels for debris and clean as needed. Lubricate moving parts of the wheels and folding mechanism periodically with a silicone-based lubricant.
- **Storage:** Store the stroller in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stroller does not fold/unfold smoothly.	Mechanism obstructed or dirty.	Check for debris. Lubricate moving parts with silicone spray. Ensure all components are aligned.
Wheels are stiff or do not swivel.	Debris in wheel mechanism or lack of lubrication.	Clean wheels and axles. Apply silicone lubricant to wheel bearings. Ensure swivel locks are disengaged.
Stroller feels unstable.	Not fully locked in open position.	Ensure the frame is fully extended and all locking mechanisms have clicked into place.
