1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your ZENY Drafting Table Art Desk. This versatile desk is designed for various creative and professional tasks, featuring a durable construction, adjustable height, and a tiltable tabletop. It includes integrated storage solutions and a drafting stool for convenience.

The ZENY Drafting Table is constructed from durable steel and wood, providing a stable and smooth work surface. Key features include:

- **Adjustable Height:** The table height can be adjusted from 28 inches to 35.8 inches.
- **Adjustable Tabletop Angle:** The main tabletop can be tilted between 0 and 60 degrees.
- **Double Tabletop:** Features a main work surface (34" x 23.6") and a slide-out side table (15" x 23.6").
- **Integrated Storage:** Includes two slide-out drawers, a storage shelf, and a pencil box.
- **Included Stool:** A 20-inch high stool is provided for comfortable use.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components are present and undamaged. Refer to the packing list included with your product for a complete inventory of parts and hardware. The package typically includes:

- Main tabletop and slide-out side table
- Steel frame components (legs, crossbars)
- Two fabric storage drawers
- Drafting stool components
- Assembly hardware (screws, bolts, washers, Allen wrench)
- Pencil ledge and pencil box

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly typically requires two people. Please refer to the detailed step-by-step instructions and diagrams provided in the separate assembly manual included in your package. The general assembly process involves:

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Lay out all components and hardware on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Compare with the packing list.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Attach the leg frames to the crossbars using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are secure but do not fully tighten until the frame is stable.
3. **Attach the Main Tabletop:** Secure the main tabletop to the assembled frame. Pay attention to the orientation for the tilting mechanism.
4. **Install Storage Components:** Insert the fabric drawers into their designated slots and attach the lower storage shelf.
5. **Assemble the Slide-out Table:** Attach the slide-out table mechanism and the table surface. Ensure it slides smoothly.
6. **Assemble the Stool:** Follow the separate instructions for assembling the drafting stool.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place and the desk is stable, fully tighten all screws and bolts.

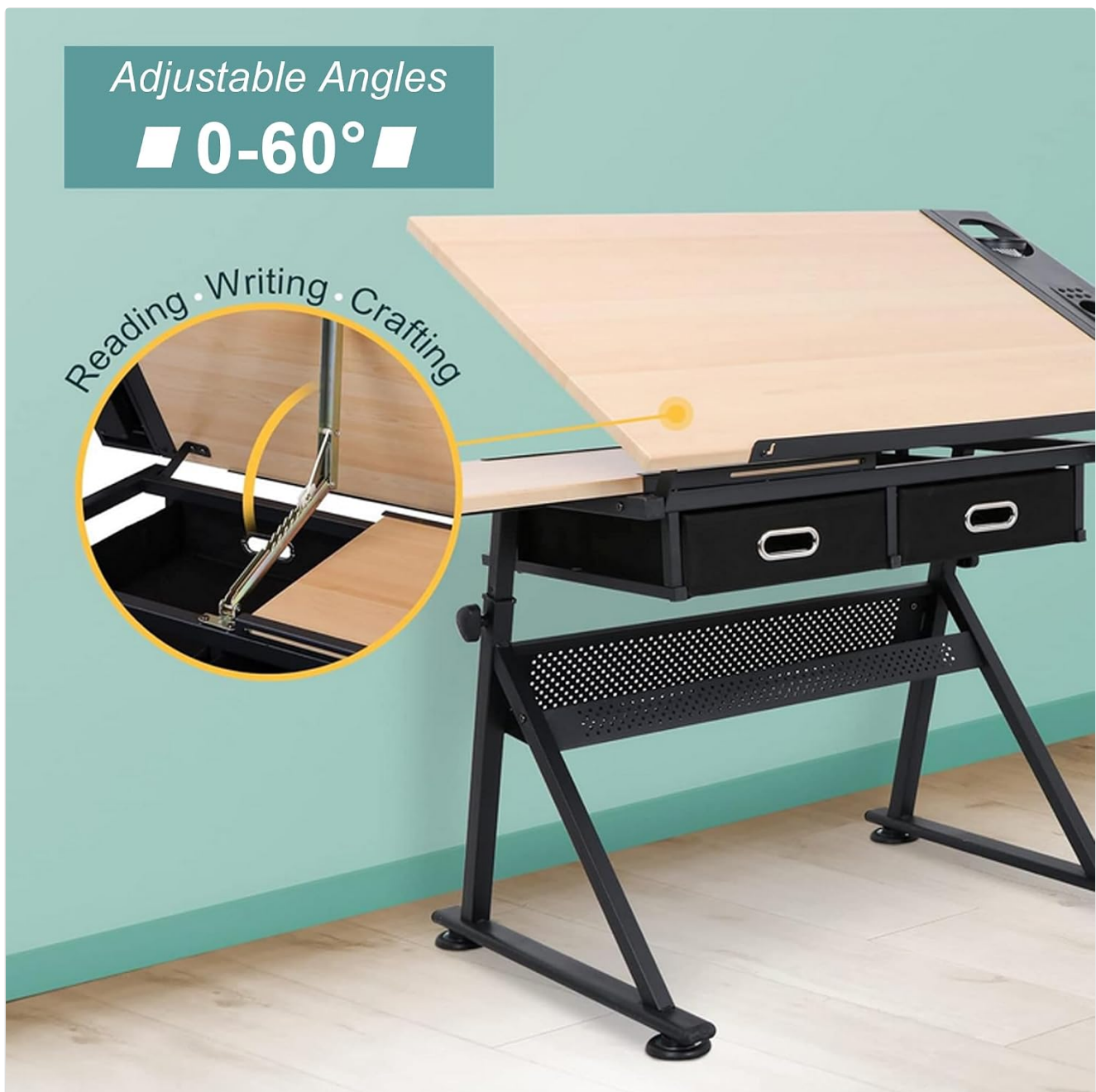


Figure 3: Example of a frame assembly step

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Height Adjustment

The table's height can be adjusted to suit your preference, whether sitting or standing. Locate the adjustment knobs on the legs of the table. Loosen these knobs, adjust the table to the desired height between 28 inches and 35.8 inches, and then securely tighten the knobs to lock the table in position.

5.2 Tabletop Angle Adjustment

The main tabletop can be tilted to an angle between 0 and 60 degrees. To adjust, lift the tabletop slightly and engage the support mechanism to select your desired angle. Ensure the tabletop is securely locked in place before applying pressure. The pencil ledge should be in place to prevent items from sliding off when tilted.

5.3 Slide-out Side Table

A smaller, auxiliary table can be pulled out from the side of the main tabletop, providing additional space for tools, a laptop, or beverages. Gently pull the side table outwards until it reaches its full extension. Push it back in when not in use to save space.

5.4 Storage Features

The desk includes two slide-out fabric drawers located beneath the main tabletop for storing papers, small tools, and supplies. A perforated metal shelf below the drawers provides additional storage space for larger items or art supplies. A dedicated pencil box is also integrated into the side of the main tabletop.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your ZENY Drafting Table, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the surfaces with a dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that may damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any loose hardware to maintain stability.
- **Moving the Table:** When moving the table, lift it rather than dragging it to prevent damage to the legs or flooring.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your drafting table, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Table is Wobbly:**
 - Ensure all assembly bolts and screws are fully tightened.
 - Check that the table is on a level surface. Adjust the leg levelers if necessary.

- **Difficulty Adjusting Height/Angle:**
 - Ensure adjustment knobs are sufficiently loosened before attempting to change height or angle.
 - Check for any obstructions in the adjustment mechanisms.
- **Slide-out Table Does Not Move Smoothly:**
 - Inspect the tracks for any debris or obstructions.
 - Ensure the slide-out table is correctly installed according to the assembly instructions.
- **Missing or Damaged Parts:**
 - Review the package contents list. If parts are missing or damaged upon arrival, contact ZENY customer support immediately.
