1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Windhager SNAP Mouse Trap. This reusable, poison-free snap trap is designed for effective and hygienic mouse control. Please read these instructions carefully before use to ensure safe and optimal performance.



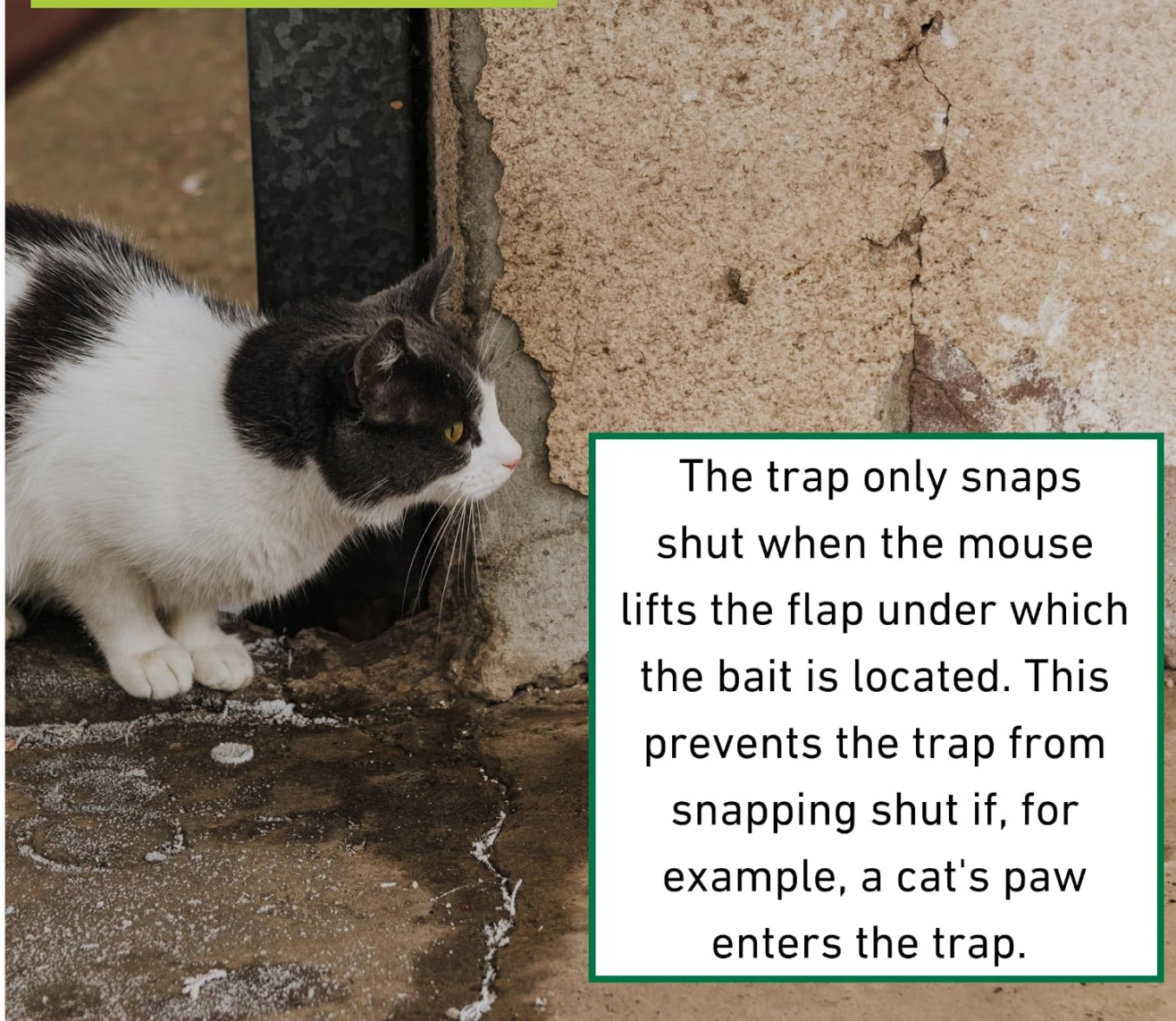
Image 1.1: The Windhager SNAP Mouse Trap, ready for use.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Keep out of reach of children and pets. The trap is designed to snap shut quickly and forcefully.
- Handle with care. Avoid placing fingers near the snapping mechanism when setting the trap.
- Do not use in areas where non-target animals could be harmed.
- Always wear gloves when handling the trap or disposing of caught rodents to prevent contact with potential pathogens.

MULTIFACETED

Protective mechanism



The trap only snaps shut when the mouse lifts the flap under which the bait is located. This prevents the trap from snapping shut if, for example, a cat's paw enters the trap.

3. SETUP

1. Baiting the Trap:

Open the bait compartment by lifting the small flap on the trap. Place a small amount of bait (e.g., peanut butter, hazelnut spread, chocolate cream, or bacon) into the designated bait cup. Close the flap securely. Avoid overfilling the bait cup.

2. Setting the Trap:

Press the rear part of the trap down firmly until it clicks into place. The trap is now armed and ready. Ensure your fingers are clear of the snapping mechanism during this process.

3. Placement:

Place the armed trap in areas where mouse activity is suspected, such as along walls, in corners, or near entry points. Mice tend to travel along edges. For best results, place the trap parallel to the wall with the bait entrance facing the wall.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once set, the Windhager SNAP Mouse Trap will activate when a mouse attempts to access the bait by lifting the bait flap. The trap is designed for a quick and humane catch.

- Regularly check the traps.
- Upon a successful catch, the trap will be in its closed position.
- To dispose of the caught mouse, hold the trap over a waste bin and press the rear part of the trap to release the mouse without direct contact.
- The trap can then be re-baited and reset for continued use.

5. MAINTENANCE

The Windhager SNAP Mouse Trap is made from high-quality plastic, making it durable and easy to clean for repeated use.

- After each use, clean the trap with warm, soapy water.
- Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry completely before re-baiting and resetting.
- Proper cleaning helps remove residual odors that might deter future catches.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

• Trap not catching:

- Ensure the trap is properly baited with an attractive food source.
- Verify the trap is fully armed and clicked into place.
- Check placement: Mice often prefer to run along walls. Place the trap perpendicular or parallel to the wall with the bait entrance facing the wall.
- Consider using multiple traps in different locations.

• Bait taken, but no catch:

- The amount of bait might be too large, allowing the mouse to eat without triggering the trap. Use a pea-sized amount.
- The bait might not be sticky enough to require the mouse to pull at it, thus not triggering the mechanism. Use sticky baits like peanut butter.
- Ensure the trap is placed on a stable, flat surface.
