SETUP

Charging the Headphones

The PSB M4U 8 headphones are powered by rechargeable AAA batteries (included). To charge, connect the supplied Micro USB Charging Cable to the headphone's USB port and to a power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The LED indicator will show charging status.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
2. Press and hold the power button until the LED indicator flashes blue and red, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "PSB M4U 8" from the list of devices.
5. Once connected, the LED indicator will turn solid blue.

NFC Pairing (if supported by your device)

For devices with NFC, simply tap your device against the NFC area on the headphone's ear cup to initiate automatic pairing.

Wired Connection

To use the headphones with a wired connection, connect the 3.5mm Analogue Cable to the headphone's audio jack and to your audio source. This allows for listening even if the batteries are depleted (Passive Mode).

OPERATING THE HEADPHONES

Operation Modes

- **Active Noise Cancelling (ANC) Mode:** Reduces ambient noise for an immersive listening experience. Ideal for travel or noisy environments.
- **Active Mode:** Provides amplified sound with RoomFeel technology, enhancing the audio quality without noise cancellation.
- **Passive Mode:** Operates without battery power using the 3.5mm audio cable. No amplification or noise cancellation is active in this mode.
- **Listen-Through Mode:** Utilizes the built-in microphones to allow you to hear your surroundings without removing the headphones. This is useful for announcements or brief conversations.

Controls

The headphones feature intuitive on-ear controls for managing music playback, volume, and phone calls. Refer to the specific button layout on your headphones for detailed functions (e.g., play/pause, track skip, volume up/down, answer/end call).

Making and Receiving Calls

When connected via Bluetooth, you can answer incoming calls by pressing the designated call button on the headphones. Use the built-in microphone for hands-free communication. Press the button again to end the call.

MAINTENANCE

- Clean the headphones regularly with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid exposing the headphones to extreme temperatures, moisture, or direct sunlight.
- Store the headphones in the provided travel case when not in use to protect them from damage.
- The ear pads are replaceable; follow instructions for proper removal and installation if replacement is needed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power:** Ensure batteries are charged. If using wired, check cable connection.
- **No Sound:** Check volume levels on both headphones and connected device. Ensure proper Bluetooth pairing or wired connection.
- **Bluetooth Disconnection:** Ensure headphones are within the 10-meter wireless range. Re-pair if necessary.
- **Poor Sound Quality:** Check audio source quality. Ensure headphones are in the desired operating mode (Active, ANC).
- **ANC Not Working:** Ensure ANC mode is activated. Check battery level.


