# **Timex Unisex Expedition Scout 36 Watch Instruction Manual**

#### Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the proper use and care of your Timex Unisex Expedition Scout 36 Watch. This 36mm field watch features a durable metal construction, a comfortable blue nylon strap, 12/24-hour military time markings, and the signature arrow second hand. #### SETUP AND INITIAL OPERATION

## 1. Setting the Time

- 1. Pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch) out to position 2. The second hand will stop.
- 2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time.
- 3. Push the crown back into position 1 to restart the watch.

# 2. Setting the Date

- 1. Pull the crown out to position 1.5 (halfway between position 1 and 2).
- 2. Turn the crown clockwise to advance the date. Continue until the correct date is displayed.
- 3. Once the date is set, push the crown back into position 1.

# 3. Adjusting the Strap

The blue nylon strap is adjustable to fit various wrist sizes. Thread the strap through the buckle and secure it using the appropriate hole for a comfortable fit. The strap is designed for durability and comfort.

# **OPERATING FEATURES**

# **Indiglo Night-Light**

Your Timex Expedition Scout 36 Watch is equipped with the Indiglo night-light feature. To activate the Indiglo backlight, press and hold the crown (in position 1). The entire dial will illuminate for easy reading in low-light conditions.

## **Water Resistance**

This watch is water resistant to 50 meters (165 feet). This rating means the watch is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming. It is not recommended for diving or snorkeling. Avoid operating the crown while the watch is wet or submerged to prevent water intrusion.

## **M**AINTENANCE

#### **Battery Replacement**

The watch uses one Lithium Metal battery (CR2016), which is included. The estimated battery life is up to 10 years. When the battery needs replacement, it is recommended to have it replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure the water resistance seal is maintained.

## **Cleaning**

To clean your watch, wipe the case with a soft, damp cloth. The nylon strap can be gently hand-washed with mild soap and water, then air-dried. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the watch's finish or strap.

#### **Strap Care**

Regularly inspect the nylon strap for any signs of wear or damage. While durable, prolonged exposure to direct sunlight or harsh chemicals can affect its integrity. Replacement straps are available from authorized Timex retailers.

#### **T**ROUBLESHOOTING

- Watch Not Running: Ensure the crown is fully pushed into position 1. If the watch still does not run, the battery may need replacement.
- Indiglo Not Working: Check if the crown is fully depressed when attempting to activate Indiglo. If it still doesn't work, the battery might be low or require replacement.
- **Date Not Changing:** Verify that the time is set correctly for AM/PM. The date typically changes around midnight. If the date is stuck, try manually advancing it using the crown in position 1.5.
- Loud Ticking Sound: Some Timex watches, including this model, may produce an audible ticking sound. This is a characteristic of the movement and is generally not an indication of a defect.
