INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Cook's Essentials 3.4-qt Digital Air Fryer. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain this manual for future reference. This appliance is designed to cook a variety of foods using rapid hot air circulation, offering a healthier alternative to traditional deep frying.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before operating the air fryer.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electric shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). To reduce the risk of electric shock, this plug is intended to fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to modify the plug in any way.

BEFORE FIRST USE

1. Remove all packaging materials, stickers, and labels from the appliance.
2. Clean the fry basket and basket holder thoroughly with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge.
3. Wipe the inside and outside of the appliance with a damp cloth.
4. Do not immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.
5. Ensure all parts are completely dry before use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Control Panel Overview:

The Cook's Essentials Digital Air Fryer features an intuitive LED display and touch controls for easy operation. The control panel includes preset icons for common dishes, as well as manual temperature and time adjustment buttons.

Basic Operation:

1. Place the air fryer on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
2. Pull out the fry basket from the main unit.
3. Place ingredients into the fry basket. Do not overfill.
4. Slide the fry basket back into the air fryer until it clicks into place.

5. Plug the power cord into a grounded wall outlet. The appliance will beep, and the power button will illuminate.
6. Press the Power button to turn on the display.

Using Presets:

The air fryer comes with seven one-touch presets for convenience:

- French Fries
- Steak
- Chicken
- Fish
- Chips
- Chicken Wings
- Quick 5 (a general quick cooking setting)

To use a preset, simply press the corresponding icon on the control panel. The air fryer will automatically set the optimal temperature and time for that food item. You can adjust the time and temperature manually even after selecting a preset if desired.

Manual Cooking:

1. After turning on the display, use the temperature control buttons (+ / - with thermometer icon) to set your desired cooking temperature. The temperature range is typically from 180°F to 400°F (80°C to 200°C).
2. Use the time control buttons (+ / - with clock icon) to set your desired cooking time, up to 30 minutes.
3. Press the Power button again to start the cooking process. The fan and heating element will activate.
4. During cooking, you can pull out the basket to shake or flip food. The air fryer will pause automatically and resume when the basket is reinserted.
5. Once the timer reaches zero, the air fryer will beep and automatically shut off.

Cooking Tips:

- For best results, preheat the air fryer for 3-5 minutes before adding food.
- Shake or flip food halfway through cooking for even browning.
- Lightly spray or toss food with a small amount of oil for crispier results.
- Do not overcrowd the basket; cook in batches if necessary.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Clean the air fryer after every use.

1. Unplug the air fryer from the wall outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. The fry basket and basket holder are dishwasher-safe. Alternatively, wash them with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge.
3. Wipe the exterior of the air fryer with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh abrasive cleaners.
4. Clean the interior of the appliance with a non-abrasive sponge and warm, soapy water.
5. Ensure all parts are thoroughly dry before storing or using again.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air fryer does not turn on.	Appliance is not plugged in. Power outlet is not working.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a grounded outlet. Check the circuit breaker.
Food is not cooked evenly.	Basket is overcrowded. Food pieces are too large.	Cook in smaller batches. Cut food into smaller, more uniform pieces. Shake or flip food halfway through cooking.
White smoke coming from the appliance.	Grease residue from previous use. Fatty ingredients being cooked.	Clean the basket and interior thoroughly after each use. For fatty foods, drain excess oil from the basket during cooking.
Food is not crispy.	Not enough oil used. Basket overcrowded. Temperature too low.	Lightly spray or toss food with a small amount of oil. Do not overcrowd the basket. Increase cooking temperature slightly.
