The Epson Workforce Pro WF-C5710 is a compact, network-ready multifunction color printer designed for efficient and cost-effective printing. It integrates printing, copying, scanning, and faxing capabilities into a single device. Featuring PrecisionCore technology, this printer aims to reduce total printing costs compared to color lasers. It offers fast print speeds, automatic two-sided printing, and a user-friendly 4.3-inch touchscreen display.

1. SETUP

1.1 Unpacking and Initial Setup

Carefully remove the printer from its packaging. Ensure all protective materials and tapes are removed before powering on the device. Refer to the 'In the Box' diagram to identify all components.

1.2 Power Connection

Connect the power cord to the printer and then to a grounded electrical outlet. Power on the printer using the power button, typically located on the control panel.

1.3 Network Connectivity

The WF-C5710 supports wireless (Wi-Fi) and Ethernet connectivity for seamless network integration. Follow the on-screen instructions on the 4.3-inch touchscreen display to configure your preferred connection method.

- **Wireless Setup:** Select the Wi-Fi option on the touchscreen, choose your network from the list, and enter the password.
- **Ethernet Setup:** Connect an Ethernet cable from your router or network hub to the Ethernet port on the printer. The printer should automatically detect the connection.

1.4 Software Installation

Install the necessary drivers and software on your computer or mobile device. This typically involves visiting the Epson support website for your model and downloading the latest software package. For mobile printing, download the Epson iPrint app.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Control Panel and Touchscreen

The printer features a 4.3-inch color touchscreen display for easy navigation and control. Use the touch interface to access various functions such as Copy, Scan, Fax, and Maintenance settings.

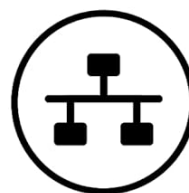

2.2 Loading Paper

The printer has a paper tray with a maximum capacity of 830 sheets. To load paper, pull out the paper tray, adjust the guides to fit the paper size, and insert the paper stack. Ensure the paper is not overloaded.

2.3 Printing Documents

To print, select the print function from your computer or mobile device. Choose the Epson WF-C5710 as your printer. You can select options such as color or black and white, single-sided or automatic 2-sided (duplex) printing. The printer offers fast speeds of up to 24 ISO ppm for both black and color prints.

2.4 Copying Documents

Place your document on the scanner glass or in the 50-page duplex Automatic Document Feeder (ADF). On the touchscreen, select 'Copy'. Adjust settings such as number of copies, color/mono, and 2-sided options, then press 'Start'. The maximum copy speed for black and white is 40 ppm.

2.5 Scanning Documents

Place your document on the scanner glass or in the ADF. On the touchscreen, select 'Scan'. You can choose to scan to a computer, network folder, or USB drive. Follow the prompts to select scan settings and initiate the scan.

2.6 Faxing Documents

Load your document on the scanner glass or in the ADF. On the touchscreen, select 'Fax'. Enter the recipient's fax number and adjust any necessary settings, then press 'Start'.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Replacing Ink Packs

The WF-C5710 uses a Replaceable Ink Pack System (CMYK liquid inkjet). When an ink pack is low or empty, the printer will display a notification. To replace an ink pack:

1. Open the ink pack cover on the side of the printer.
2. Remove the empty ink pack by pressing the release tab and pulling it out.
3. Unpack the new ink pack and insert it into the correct slot until it clicks into place.
4. Close the ink pack cover.

Replacement ink packs — print up to **10,000 pages black / 5,000 color**¹



¹ Replacement ink pack yields are estimated based on ISO/IEC 24711 test in Default Mode printing continuously. Ink pack yields vary considerably for reasons including images printed, print settings, temperature and humidity. Yields may be lower when printing infrequently or predominantly with one ink color. All ink colors are used for printing and printer maintenance, and all colors have to be installed for printing. For print quality, part of the ink from the included ink packs is used for printer startup and a variable amount of ink remains in the ink pack after the "replace ink pack" signal. 3.2 Cleaning the Printer

Regular cleaning helps maintain print quality and extends the life of your printer. Use a soft, lint-free cloth to wipe the exterior. For print head cleaning or nozzle checks, access the 'Maintenance' section through the touchscreen display and follow the instructions.

3.3 Firmware Updates

Ensure your printer's firmware is up to date for optimal performance and security. Check for updates periodically through the printer's settings menu or the Epson support website.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Epson WF-C5710, refer to the following general troubleshooting tips:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely connected to both the printer and the electrical outlet.
- **Printing Issues:** Check ink levels, paper loading, and network connection. Perform a print head nozzle check and cleaning if print quality is poor.
- **Network Problems:** Verify Wi-Fi or Ethernet cable connection. Restart your router and printer.
- **Error Messages:** Consult the printer's touchscreen display for specific error codes and recommended solutions.
