WILSON A200 Diamondbacks 10" Tee Ball Glove User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and care of your WILSON A200 Diamondbacks 10-inch Tee Ball Glove. Designed for youth players, this glove features an H-Web construction and is adorned with Arizona Diamondbacks colors and logos. Adhering to these instructions will help ensure the glove's longevity and optimal performance.

2. SETUP AND FIRST USE

2.1 Hand Orientation

It is important to select the correct glove for your throwing hand:

- **Right Hand Throw:** The glove is worn on the left hand.
- **Left Hand Throw:** The glove is worn on the right hand.

2.2 Breaking In Your Glove

New baseball gloves, especially those made of leather, require a break-in period to become flexible and comfortable for use. While this glove is designed to be easy for beginners to close, the following steps can

assist in the break-in process:

1. **Play Catch:** The most effective way to break in a glove is by regularly playing catch. The impact of the ball helps to soften the leather and form a pocket.
2. **Flex and Squeeze:** Repeatedly flex and squeeze the glove with your hand to work the leather and create natural creases.
3. **Form the Pocket:** Place a baseball in the pocket and wrap the glove with a strap or elastic band when not in use to help maintain the pocket shape.

Avoid using excessive oils or heating methods, as these can damage the leather and reduce the glove's lifespan.

3. OPERATING YOUR GLOVE

Once the glove is sufficiently broken in, it is ready for play. Insert your hand fully into the glove, ensuring your fingers are comfortably seated in their respective stalls. The glove should feel secure but not overly tight. When catching, aim to receive the ball in the glove's pocket, closing your hand around it to secure the catch.

4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your WILSON A200 Tee Ball Glove:

- **Cleaning:** After use, wipe down the glove with a slightly damp cloth to remove dirt and moisture. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Drying:** If the glove gets wet, allow it to air dry naturally at room temperature. Do not use direct heat sources like hair dryers or radiators, as this can cause the leather to crack or stiffen.
- **Storage:** Store the glove in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. To help maintain its shape, you can place a baseball in the pocket and wrap it loosely.
- **Conditioning (Optional):** Periodically, a small amount of leather conditioner specifically designed for baseball gloves can be applied to keep the leather supple. Follow the conditioner manufacturer's instructions carefully.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Glove Stiffness

If your glove feels too stiff even after initial use, it likely requires further break-in. Continue playing catch and flexing the glove regularly. The leather will soften over time with consistent use.
