1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Choking Hazard:** This product contains small parts and is not suitable for children under 3 years of age.
- Adult supervision is recommended during play, especially when using the water pump feature.
- Ensure all parts are securely assembled before play to prevent detachment and potential hazards.

3. SETUP

3.1 Package Contents

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly. The set includes approximately 40 pieces.

- 2 Firefighter figures
- 1 Extinguishing water pump unit
- 2 Repositionable flame accessories
- Hoses and connectors
- Various firefighter tools and accessories (e.g., axe, fire extinguisher)

3.2 Assembly Instructions

Follow these steps to assemble your Playmobil Firefighters with Water Pump set:

1. Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. Assemble the firefighter figures by attaching helmets, air tanks, and any other small accessories as indicated in the included pictorial instructions (not shown here).
3. Connect the hose to the water pump unit. Ensure a secure fit to prevent leaks.
4. Attach the nozzle to the other end of the hose.
5. Position the repositionable flame accessories as desired for play scenarios.

For detailed visual assembly, refer to the pictorial instructions provided within the product packaging.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The water pump feature allows for realistic firefighting play.

1. **Fill the Water Pump:** Open the cap on the water pump unit and carefully fill the reservoir with clean tap water. Do not overfill.
2. **Connect the Hose:** Ensure the hose is firmly connected to both the pump unit and the firefighter's nozzle.
3. **Operate the Pump:** Place the nozzle towards the target (e.g., the flame accessories). Press down repeatedly on the plunger at the top of the water pump unit to spray water.
4. **Connect to Other Sets:** The water pump can be connected to other Playmobil fire-themed sets such as the Fire Ladder Unit, Fire Engine, and Fire Truck (Models #9463, #9464, and #9466, each sold separately) for extended play.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your Playmobil set.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe figures and accessories with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Water Pump Care:** After use, empty any remaining water from the pump unit. Allow it to air dry completely to prevent mold or mildew.
- **Storage:** Store the set in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all parts for damage or wear. Replace any broken or worn parts to maintain safety and functionality.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your water pump, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water pump not spraying.	No water in reservoir; hose not connected properly; airlock.	Fill reservoir with water. Check hose connections for tightness. Prime the pump by pressing the plunger several times.
Water leaking from connections.	Loose hose connection.	Ensure all hose connections are pushed firmly into place.
Weak water spray.	Low water level; partial blockage in hose/nozzle.	Refill water reservoir. Disconnect hose and nozzle, check for any obstructions, and rinse with clean water.
