The projector includes dedicated Football and Sports modes with CinemaMaster Audio+2 for an immersive experience. Its compact design allows for easy installation with vertical keystone correction and 1.2x zoom.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.1 Projector Placement

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Powering On/Off

Press the power button on the projector's control panel or the remote control to turn the unit on or off. Allow a few moments for the projector to warm up or cool down.

4.2 Focus and Zoom Adjustment

Use the focus and zoom rings located near the lens to adjust the image clarity and size. The TK800 features a 1.2x zoom for flexible screen sizing without moving the projector significantly.

4.3 Keystone Correction

The projector supports vertical keystone correction to adjust the image shape if the projector is not perfectly perpendicular to the screen. This helps in achieving a perfectly rectangular image.

4.4 Picture Modes

The BenQ TK800 offers dedicated picture modes for optimized viewing. Select the "Football Mode" or "Sports Mode" for an enhanced sports viewing experience with vibrant colors and clear sound (CinemaMaster Audio+2). Other standard picture modes are available for general entertainment.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your BenQ TK800 projector, regular maintenance is recommended. Keep the lens clean using a soft, lint-free cloth. Ensure proper ventilation around the projector to prevent overheating. Refer to the full user manual for detailed cleaning instructions and lamp replacement procedures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your BenQ TK800 projector, try the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **No Image:** Ensure all cables are securely connected and the correct input source is selected. Check the power connection.
- **Blurred Image:** Adjust the focus ring until the image is sharp.
- **Distorted Image Shape:** Use the keystone correction feature to adjust the image geometry.
- **No Sound:** Verify audio cable connections and check the projector's volume settings. Ensure the audio source is active.
