INTRODUCTION

The Breville The Sommelier Electric Hyper-Speed Decanter is designed to rapidly oxygenate wine, enhancing its flavor and aroma in significantly less time than traditional decanting methods. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your appliance.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

Please read all instructions before operating the Breville The Sommelier and save them for future reference. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always ensure the appliance is properly assembled before use.
- Do not immerse the power base, cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- Use only the provided glass carafe with the appliance. The carafe is made of thin glass and should be handled with care.
- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, level, heat-resistant surface.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not use the appliance for purposes other than its intended use.

COMPONENTS

Your Breville The Sommelier Electric Hyper-Speed Decanter includes the following parts:

- **Power Base:** Contains the electronic controls and oxygenation mechanism.
- **Glass Carafe (750ml):** Designed for optimal oxygen flow through its center column.
- **Power Cord:** For connecting the unit to an electrical outlet.

Note: A smaller 200ml glass decanter for spirits may be available separately.

SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and promotional labels from the decanter.

2. **Clean Carafe:** Wash the glass carafe thoroughly with warm soapy water, then rinse and dry completely. Do not wash the power base.
3. **Position:** Place the power base on a dry, stable, and level surface.
4. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a 120V AC power outlet. The display will illuminate.
5. **Place Carafe:** Carefully place the clean, empty glass carafe onto the power base, ensuring it is seated correctly.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Breville The Sommelier uses 90% pure oxygen to accelerate the decanting process. One minute of oxygenation is equivalent to approximately one hour of traditional decanting.

1. **Pour Wine:** Carefully pour your wine into the glass carafe. Do not overfill past the maximum fill line.
2. **Set Decanting Time:** Use the rotary dial on the power base to set the desired oxygenation time. The display shows "DECANTING TIME" in minutes and seconds. Refer to the Breville app for

recommended decanting times based on wine type, region, and vintage.

3. **Start Oxygenation:** Press the **START** button. The appliance will begin the oxygenation process, and the display will show a countdown. You will observe bubbles rising through the wine.
4. **Monitor Progress:** The display will show the remaining oxygenation time.
5. **Completion:** Once the set time has elapsed, the appliance will automatically stop. A chime may sound to indicate completion.
6. **Serve:** Carefully remove the carafe from the power base and serve the oxygenated wine.
7. **Stop/Reset:** To stop the oxygenation process prematurely or to reset the timer, press the **STOP/RESET** button.

Using with Spirits

The Sommelier can also be used to enhance spirits like whiskey or cognac. For this purpose, a smaller 200ml carafe (sold separately) is recommended. Follow the same operating steps, adjusting the oxygenation time as desired for your specific spirit.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning ensures the longevity and performance of your Breville The Sommelier.

- **Carafe Cleaning:** After each use, empty any remaining wine. Wash the glass carafe by hand with warm soapy water. Use a soft brush if necessary to clean the interior and the central oxygenation tube. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry. The carafe is made of delicate glass; handle with care to prevent breakage.
- **Power Base Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the power base with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scourers. Never immerse the power base in water or any other liquid.
- **Sediment:** If sediment accumulates in the oxygenation tube of the carafe, use a thin, flexible brush designed for cleaning narrow tubes to remove it.
- **Storage:** Store the appliance in a clean, dry place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in or power outlet issue.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet.
No bubbles during oxygenation.	Carafe not seated correctly or internal blockage.	Ensure the carafe is properly placed on the base. Check the central tube for blockages and clean if necessary.
Wine taste is not improved.	Incorrect decanting time or wine type.	Consult the Breville app for recommended decanting times. Some wines may require longer or shorter times, or may not benefit significantly from decanting.
Carafe breaks easily.	Glass is delicate.	Handle the glass carafe with extreme care. Avoid sudden temperature changes or impacts. Replacement carafes can be purchased from Breville.
