1. Introduction and Overview

It supports major 4K high dynamic range formats including Dolby Vision, HDR10, and HLG, and delivers immersive Dolby Atmos audio.

For optimal performance and longevity, please read these instructions carefully before using your television.

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 TV Placement and Stand Assembly

Choose a stable, level surface for your TV. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit. If using the included stand, carefully follow the assembly instructions provided in the separate Quick Start Guide. For wall mounting, consult a professional installer and use a VESA-compliant mount.

3.2 Power Connection

Connect the power cable securely to the TV's power input and then to a grounded electrical outlet.

3.3 Initial Setup and Connectivity

- Check weather, calendar, and other personal information.

4.3 Picture and Audio Settings

- **Picture Mode:** Select from various presets (e.g., Standard, Cinema, Game) or customize settings like brightness, contrast, and color. The α9 Intelligent Processor optimizes sharpness, depth, and color accuracy.
- HDR Settings: The TV supports 4K Cinema HDR, including Dolby Vision, HDR10, and HLG, with advanced tone-mapping for scene-by-scene optimization.
- **Sound Mode:** Choose audio presets or adjust equalizer settings. Experience immersive sound with built-in Dolby Atmos technology.

4.4 Accessing Apps and LG Channels

From the home screen, you can access a wide range of streaming applications and LG Channels, which offers free live and on-demand content. Navigate using the Magic Remote to browse and select your desired content.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Screen Cleaning

Gently wipe the screen with a soft, dry microfiber cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with distilled water. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or direct spraying of liquids onto the screen.

6.2 General Care

Keep the TV free from dust by regularly wiping the cabinet and vents with a soft, dry cloth. Ensure the ventilation openings are not blocked to prevent overheating. Avoid placing the TV in direct sunlight or near heat sources.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Power:** Check if the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and the electrical outlet. Ensure the outlet is functioning.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify that the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections to external devices. Try restarting the TV and connected devices.
- **Remote Not Working:** Replace the batteries in the Magic Remote. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV. Re-pair the remote if necessary.
- **Network Connection Issues:** Check your router and modem. Restart network equipment. Ensure Wi-Fi password is correct. Try connecting via Ethernet if Wi-Fi is unstable.
- Image Retention/Burn-in: While LG OLED TVs have features to mitigate image retention, prolonged display of static images can cause temporary or permanent effects. Use screen saver functions and avoid leaving static images on screen for extended periods.
