# Hape Kid's Flame First Musical Guitar E0602 Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

The Hape Kid's Flame First Musical Guitar is designed to introduce young children to the world of music. This 26-inch wooden guitar features four tunable nylon strings and a scaled-down body, making it suitable for small hands. It encourages musical aptitude and creative expression.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

This product is recommended for children aged 36 months and older. All Hape products sold in North America meet or exceed applicable safety standards. The guitar features durable, child-safe paint finishes and non-toxic materials.

**Warning:** Small parts may be present. Adult supervision is recommended during play.

## SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the guitar from its packaging. Inspect for any damage.
2. **Initial Inspection:** Ensure all four nylon strings are securely attached to the bridge and tuning pegs.
3. **Tuning the Strings:** The guitar features tunable nylon strings. Gently turn the tuning pegs located on the headstock to adjust the tension of each string. Adjust until the desired pitch is achieved. For best results, use a digital tuner (not included) or a reference tone.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Holding the Guitar:** Encourage the child to hold the guitar comfortably, with the body resting against their chest and the neck supported by their left hand (for right-handed players).
2. **Strumming:** Use the right hand to gently strum the strings over the soundhole. Experiment with different strumming patterns and speeds.
3. **Pressing Strings:** Use the fingers of the left hand to press down on the strings against the fretboard to change the pitch and create different notes.

4. **Exploring Sounds:** Encourage free play and exploration of various sounds and melodies.

## MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning:** The guitar's surface is finished with safe, water-based paint. Do not use alcohol or harsh cleaning agents. Wipe gently with a dry or slightly damp cloth. Avoid washing the guitar directly with water.
- **String Care:** Nylon strings are durable but can wear over time. If a string breaks, it can be replaced with a suitable nylon guitar string.
- **Storage:** Store the guitar in a dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to prevent damage to the wood and finish.

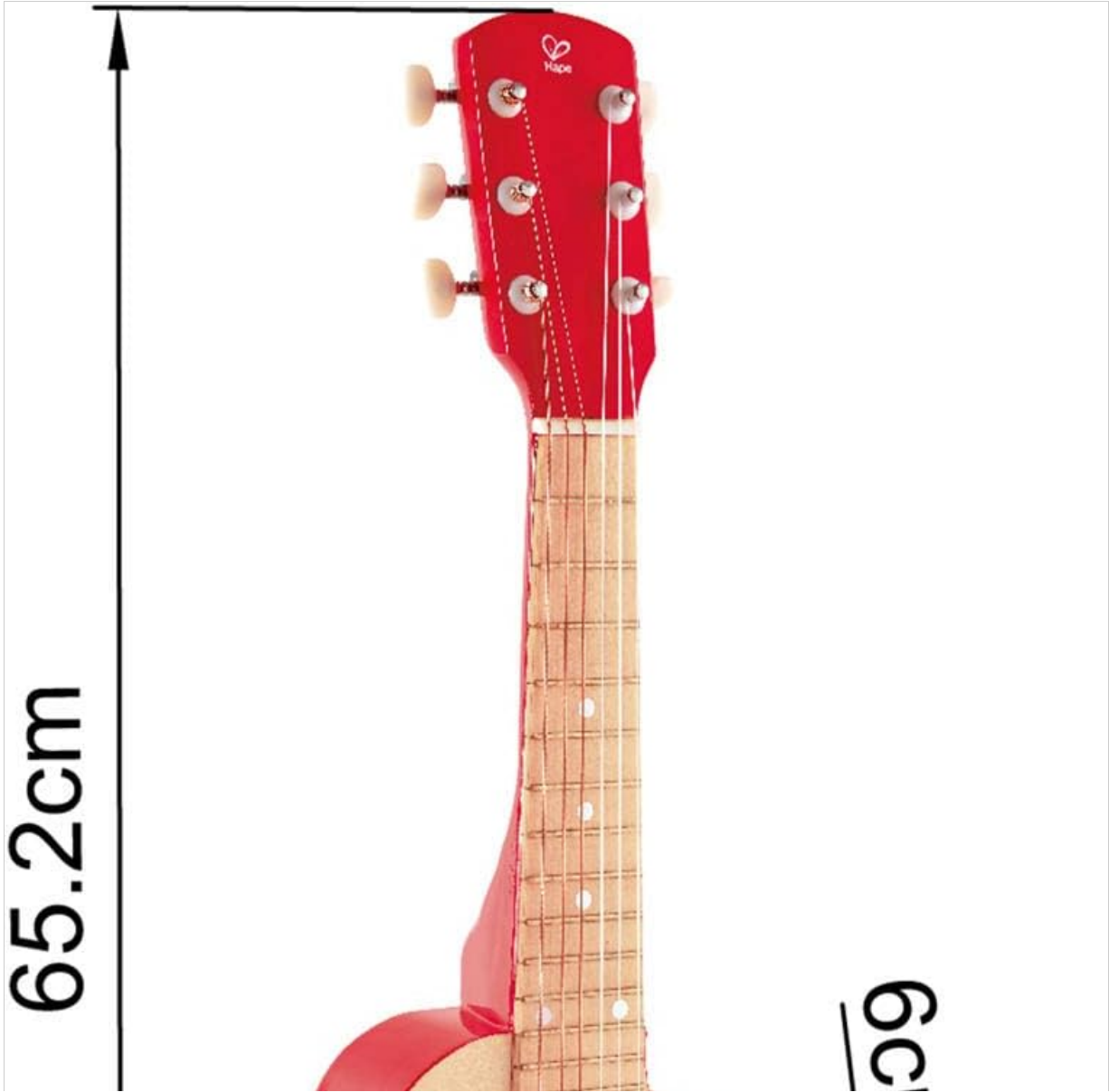
## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Strings go out of tune frequently:** Nylon strings may stretch initially. Tune the guitar regularly before each play session. Over time, they will stabilize.
- **String breaks:** Replace the broken string with a new nylon guitar string of appropriate gauge.
- **Dull sound:** Ensure strings are properly tuned and not too loose. Check for any debris in the soundhole.

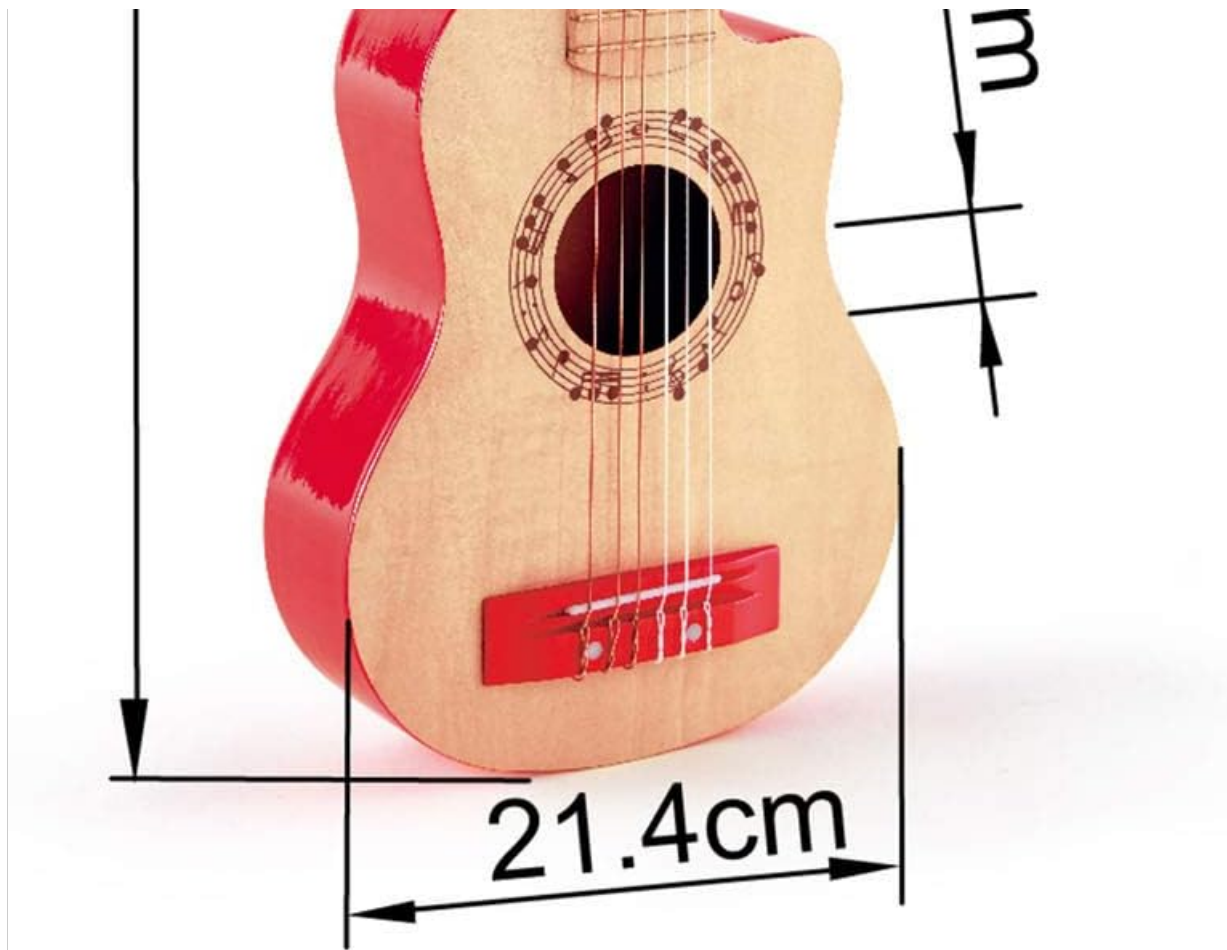


Image: The Hape musical guitar with its key dimensions (length, width, depth) indicated.

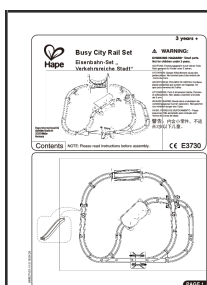
