- Use only the provided charging cable or a certified equivalent.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the speaker's components and controls:

- 1. Prev./Vol-: Press to go to the previous track; press and hold to decrease volume.
- 2. Pick Up Phone Calls: Press to answer or end a call.
- 3. Next/Vol+: Press to go to the next track; press and hold to increase volume.
- 4. Power On/Off: Press and hold to power the speaker on or off.
- 5. 3.5mm Audio Input Jack: For connecting external audio devices via AUX cable.
- 6. Micro SD Slot: For playing audio files directly from a Micro SD card.
- 7. Charging Interface: Micro USB port for charging the speaker.
- 8. Indicator Light: Displays power and connection status.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Speaker

Before first use, fully charge the speaker. The built-in 1800 mAh battery provides approximately 6 hours of playtime on a full charge, with a charging time of about 2 hours.

- 1. Connect the Micro USB charging cable to the **Charging Interface (7)** on the speaker.
- 2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
- 3. The **Indicator Light (8)** will illuminate to show charging status. It will typically turn off or change color once fully charged.

4.2 Power On/Off

- To power on, press and hold the **Power On/Off button (4)** until the indicator light illuminates and you hear an audible prompt.
- To power off, press and hold the **Power On/Off button (4)** again until the indicator light turns off and you hear an audible prompt.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Bluetooth Pairing and Playback

The EWA D560 speaker uses Bluetooth for wireless audio streaming.

- 1. Ensure the speaker is powered on and within pairing mode (the indicator light will typically flash).
- 2. Enable Bluetooth on your audio device (smartphone, tablet, computer).
- 3. Search for available Bluetooth devices and select "EWA D560" from the list.

- 4. Once paired, the indicator light will stop flashing and remain solid, and you will hear a confirmation tone.
- 5. You can now play audio from your device through the speaker.

Controlling Playback (Bluetooth Mode)

- Volume Up: Press and hold the Next/Vol+ button (3).
- Volume Down: Press and hold the Prev./Vol- button (1).
- Next Track: Press the Next/Vol+ button (3).
- Previous Track: Press the Prev./Vol- button (1).

DSP Technology

Through DSP-Tech, our engineers are able to define the sound which comes out from the speaker, so that we can ensure un-expecting sound performance

5.2 AUX Input Mode

Connect non-Bluetooth devices using the provided 3.5mm AUX cable.

- 1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm AUX cable to the 3.5mm Audio Input Jack (5) on the speaker.
- 2. Connect the other end of the AUX cable to the audio output jack of your external device.
- 3. The speaker will automatically switch to AUX mode.
- 4. Control playback and volume directly from your connected device.

5.3 Micro SD Card Playback

Play audio files directly from a Micro SD card.

- 1. Insert a Micro SD card (with supported audio files) into the Micro SD Slot (6) until it clicks into place.
- 2. The speaker will automatically detect the card and begin playing audio.
- 3. Use the Next/Vol+ (3) and Prev./Vol- (1) buttons to navigate tracks.

5.4 Hands-Free Calling

When connected via Bluetooth to a smartphone, the speaker can be used for hands-free calls.

- Answer Call: Press the Pick Up Phone Calls button (2) once when an incoming call rings.
- End Call: Press the Pick Up Phone Calls button (2) once during a call to hang up.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the speaker with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents.

6.2 Storage

- Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- If storing for an extended period, charge the battery periodically to maintain its lifespan.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your EWA D560 speaker, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Speaker does not power on.	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the speaker to a power source using the Micro USB cable.
No sound from the speaker.	Check if the speaker's volume is turned up. Ensure the connected device's volume is turned up. Verify the speaker is correctly paired via Bluetooth or the AUX cable is fully inserted. If using Micro SD, ensure the card is inserted correctly and contains supported audio files.
Unable to pair via Bluetooth.	Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode (indicator light flashing). Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device. Move the speaker closer to your device. Forget "EWA D560" from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.
Poor audio quality.	Ensure there are no obstructions between the speaker and the Bluetooth device. Try moving closer to the speaker. Check the audio source quality.
