INTRODUCTION

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to properly install your new replacement grates into your Green Mountain Grills Daniel Boone pellet grill:

1. **Ensure Grill is Off and Cool:** Before beginning, make sure your grill is completely turned off, unplugged, and cool to the touch to prevent burns or injury.
2. **Open Grill Lid:** Lift the lid of your Daniel Boone grill to access the cooking chamber.
3. **Remove Old Grates:** Carefully lift out the existing cooking grates. If they are hot, use heat-resistant gloves.
4. **Clean Grill Interior (Optional but Recommended):** This is a good opportunity to clean any ash or debris from the cooking chamber and drip tray.
5. **Insert New Grates:** Place the new Green Mountain Grills replacement grates into the grill. Ensure they sit flat and are properly aligned within the cooking chamber. The set includes a left and a right grate.
6. **Close Lid:** Once the grates are in place, close the grill lid.

OPERATING GUIDELINES

These replacement grates function identically to your original Green Mountain Grills Daniel Boone cooking grates. For optimal cooking results and to prevent food from sticking, it is recommended to:

- **Preheat Thoroughly:** Always preheat your grill to the desired cooking temperature before placing food on the grates.
- **Clean Before Use:** Ensure grates are clean before each cooking session.
- **Lightly Oil (Optional):** For certain foods, a light coating of high-smoke-point cooking oil on the grates can help prevent sticking.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your stainless steel grates and ensure consistent cooking performance.

1. **After Each Use:** While the grates are still warm (but not excessively hot), use a grill brush to scrape off any food residue.
2. **Deep Cleaning:** For a more thorough cleaning, allow the grates to cool completely. They can be washed with warm, soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge or brush. Rinse thoroughly and dry immediately to prevent water spots.
3. **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners or steel wool, as these can scratch the stainless steel surface.
4. **Storage:** Store clean, dry grates in a protected area when not in use for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your replacement grates, consider the following:

- **Grates Do Not Fit:**
Solution: Double-check your grill model to ensure it is a Green Mountain Grills Daniel Boone model (Choice, Prime, or earlier versions). Verify the dimensions of the grates against your grill's specifications. The dimensions are approximately 16.7 x 13.5 x 1.5 inches per grate.
- **Food Sticking:**
Solution: Ensure the grates are thoroughly preheated before placing food. Clean grates properly after each use. A light application of cooking oil before grilling can also help.
