INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your Frigidaire FG4H2272UF 36-inch Gallery Series Counter Depth French Door Refrigerator. Please read all instructions carefully before using your appliance to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using this appliance to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Ensure the refrigerator is properly grounded.
- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.
- Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the performance and safety of your refrigerator.

Unpacking

Remove all packaging materials, tape, and protective film from the refrigerator. Dispose of packaging materials responsibly.

Location Requirements

- Place the refrigerator on a level, sturdy floor capable of supporting its weight.
- Allow adequate clearance around the appliance for proper air circulation (minimum 1 inch at sides and back, 2 inches at top).
- Avoid direct sunlight or proximity to heat sources like ovens or radiators.
- Ensure the refrigerator is connected to a dedicated, grounded electrical outlet.

Leveling the Refrigerator

Use the leveling legs to ensure the refrigerator is stable and the doors close properly. The front should be slightly higher than the back to allow doors to close easily.

Door Alignment

Adjust the door hinges if necessary to ensure proper alignment and a tight seal.

OPERATING YOUR REFRIGERATOR

Your Frigidaire refrigerator is designed for efficient food storage with various features to maintain freshness.

Temperature Control

The electronic temperature controls are located on the dispenser panel. Set the refrigerator and freezer temperatures according to your needs. Recommended settings are typically 37°F (3°C) for the refrigerator and

0°F (-18°C) for the freezer.

Interior Features

- **Adjustable Shelves:** Customize shelf height to accommodate various food items.
- **Crisper Drawers:** Designed to maintain optimal humidity levels for fruits and vegetables.
- **Custom-Flex Temp Drawer:** This versatile drawer allows you to select specific temperature settings for different food types, such as meat, seafood, cold drinks, or wine.

Freezer Compartment

The bottom freezer drawer provides ample space for frozen goods. Ensure packages are sealed to prevent freezer burn.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance helps ensure your refrigerator operates efficiently and extends its lifespan.

Cleaning the Interior

Clean the interior regularly with a mild soap and water solution. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Remove shelves and drawers for easier cleaning.

Cleaning the Exterior (Stainless Steel)

For stainless steel surfaces, use a soft cloth and a non-abrasive stainless steel cleaner. Always wipe in the direction of the grain to prevent streaking. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.

Condenser Coils

Periodically clean the condenser coils located at the back or bottom of the refrigerator. Dust and debris can accumulate, reducing efficiency. Unplug the appliance before cleaning.

Frost Free System

Your refrigerator features a Frost Free defrost system, which automatically prevents frost buildup in the freezer compartment. Manual defrosting is not required.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before calling for service, review the following common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator not cooling	Power outage; thermostat set too high; door left open; condenser coils dirty.	Check power supply; adjust thermostat; ensure door is closed; clean condenser coils.
Ice maker not producing ice	Water supply turned off; clogged water filter; ice maker switch off; freezer temperature too high.	Check water line connection and valve; replace water filter; ensure ice maker switch is ON; lower freezer temperature.
Unusual noises	Refrigerator not level; items vibrating against each other; normal operating sounds (e.g., defrost cycle, compressor).	Level the refrigerator; rearrange items; consult the "Normal Operating Sounds" section in the full manual (if available).
Water leaking	Clogged defrost drain; loose water line connection.	Clear defrost drain; tighten water line connections.

If problems persist after attempting these solutions, contact qualified service personnel.
