1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

The Monopoly Gamer Mario Kart board game combines the classic property-trading gameplay of Monopoly with the exciting world of Mario Kart. Players race around the game board, collecting coins, using Power-Ups, and battling Bosses to win the game. 


Figure 1: The Monopoly Gamer Mario Kart game box.

2. GAME COMPONENTS

4.1 Player Turn

On your turn, follow these steps:

1. **Roll the Dice:** Roll both the Numbered Die and the Power-Up Die.
2. **Move Your Character:** Move your Character Token clockwise the number of spaces indicated on the Numbered Die.
3. **Perform Action:** Perform the action of the space you landed on. This could include collecting coins, drawing an Item Card, or initiating a Boss Battle.
4. **Use Power-Up:** Use the Power-Up ability indicated by the Power-Up Die. Each character has a unique Power-Up ability.

4.2 Collecting Coins

Coins are the currency in Monopoly Gamer Mario Kart. You collect coins by landing on certain spaces, using Power-Ups, or winning Boss Battles. The player with the most coins at the end of the game wins.

4.3 Power-Ups and Item Cards

Power-Ups are activated by the Power-Up Die and provide special abilities unique to each character. Item Cards are drawn from the Item Card pile and can be used to gain advantages during the game.

4.4 Boss Battles

When a player passes or lands on the GO space, a Boss Battle is triggered. Players race to defeat the Boss by rolling the dice and using their Power-Ups and Item Cards. The player who defeats the Boss earns points and other rewards.

4.5 Game End

The game ends after the final Boss has been defeated. Players then count their points from collected coins and defeated Bosses. The player with the highest total score wins.




Figure 6: Product dimensions for the game box.


