## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Maxwest Nitro 5N is an Android 7.0 smartphone designed for reliable communication and multimedia use. It features a 5-inch display, a Quad Core processor, and dual SIM capability, making it suitable for various global GSM networks.



# 2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening your Maxwest Nitro 5N package, please ensure all the following items are present:

- Maxwest Nitro 5N Smartphone
- Battery (2000 mAh)
- Charger Adapter
- USB Cable
- · Protective Case Cover

#### 3. INITIAL SETUP

## 3.1. Inserting the SIM Card(s) and Battery

- 1. Power Off: Ensure your Maxwest Nitro 5N is powered off before proceeding.
- 2. Remove Back Cover: Carefully remove the back cover of the phone.
- Insert SIM Card(s): Locate the SIM card slots. This device supports dual SIM cards. Insert your GSM SIM card(s) into the designated slots with the gold contacts facing down. Ensure they are securely seated.
- 4. **Insert Battery:** Place the 2000 mAh battery into its compartment, aligning the gold contacts on the battery with those in the phone.
- 5. Replace Back Cover: Carefully reattach the back cover until it clicks into place.

# 3.2. Powering On and Initial Configuration

- 1. Power On: Press and hold the Power button (usually on the side) until the Maxwest logo appears.
- 2. Language Selection: Follow the on-screen prompts to select your preferred language.
- 3. **Wi-Fi Connection:** Connect to a Wi-Fi network to complete the setup process and download necessary updates.
- 4. **Google Account:** Sign in with your Google account or create a new one. This is essential for accessing the Google Play Store and other Google services.
- 5. **Date & Time:** Set the correct date and time, or allow the network to set it automatically.

6. Security: Configure screen lock options such as PIN, pattern, or password for device security.

Important Note: This device is designed to work with GSM carriers such as AT&T, T-Mobile, and Metro PCS. It will NOT work with CDMA carriers like Verizon, Sprint, or Boost Mobile.

## 4. OPERATING YOUR MAXWEST NITRO 5N

# 4.1. Basic Navigation

- **Touchscreen:** Interact with the device by tapping, swiping, pinching, and spreading on the 5-inch LCD display.
- **Home Screen:** The central hub for your apps and widgets. Swipe left or right to access additional screens.
- Notification Panel: Swipe down from the top of the screen to access notifications and quick settings.
- **Navigation Buttons:** Use the on-screen navigation buttons (Back, Home, Recent Apps) at the bottom of the display.

# 4.2. Making Calls and Sending Messages

- Phone App: Tap the Phone icon to access the dialer, call logs, and contacts.
- Messages App: Tap the Messages icon to send and receive SMS/MMS messages.

#### 4.3. Camera Usage

Your Nitro 5N is equipped with 5MP front and rear cameras.

- 1. **Open Camera:** Tap the Camera icon on your home screen or app drawer.
- 2. **Switch Cameras:** Tap the camera switch icon to toggle between the front and rear cameras.
- 3. Take Photo/Video: Tap the shutter button to capture a photo or start/stop video recording.

#### 4.4. Screen Pinning Feature

Screen Pinning allows you to lock your phone to a single application, preventing others from accessing other apps or settings. This is useful when sharing your phone temporarily.

- 1. **Enable Screen Pinning:** Go to *Settings > Security > Screen pinning* and turn it on.
- 2. **Pin an App:** Open the app you wish to pin. Tap the Recent Apps button (square icon). Swipe up on the app's preview and tap the pin icon.
- 3. **Unpin an App:** To unpin, simultaneously press and hold the Back and Recent Apps buttons. You may need to enter your PIN/pattern/password if required by your security settings.

#### 5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

#### 5.1. Battery Care

- **Charging:** Use only the provided charger and USB cable. Avoid overcharging by disconnecting the charger once the battery is full.
- Temperature: Avoid exposing the phone to extreme temperatures, as this can degrade battery life.
- **Storage:** If storing the phone for an extended period, ensure the battery is partially charged (around 50%).

# 5.2. Cleaning Your Device

- Screen: Use a soft, lint-free cloth, slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner, to gently wipe the display.
- Body: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the phone's body. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

# 5.3. Software Updates

Periodically check for system updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to *Settings > About phone > System updates* to check for and install available updates.

# 6. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Problem	Possible Solution	
Phone does not power on.	Ensure the battery is correctly inserted and charged. Connect the charger and try again.	
No network signal.	Verify SIM card insertion. Check if you are within network coverage. Ensure your carrier is GSM compatible (e.g., AT&T, T-Mobile). Restart the phone.	
Apps are slow or crashing.	Close background apps. Clear app cache (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage > Clear cache). Restart the phone. Ensure sufficient storage space.	
Battery drains quickly.	Reduce screen brightness. Disable Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, and GPS when not in use. Close unnecessary background apps. Check battery usage in settings to identify power-hungry apps.	
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi.	Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled. Restart your router and phone. Forget the network and reconnect.
