1. INTRODUCTION

The Pantone TPG 8.5x11 Sheet provides a full-size representation of a single Pantone Fashion, Home + Interiors (FHI) color. This specific sheet features the color 17-1464 Red Orange. - **Color Evaluation:** Use the full sheet to evaluate the color 17-1464 Red Orange under various lighting conditions. Compare it against other materials or design elements to ensure harmony and accuracy.
- **Color Communication:** Share the physical sheet or cut chips with manufacturers, clients, or team members to ensure everyone is referencing the exact same color standard. This minimizes misinterpretation.
- **Color Specification:** When specifying colors for products, attach a chip from the TPG sheet to design documents or production orders. The printed color name and number on the back of each chip provide clear identification.
- **Chipping:** Utilize the 1x1 inch grid on the back of the sheet to cut out small, consistent color samples. Use sharp scissors or a craft knife for clean edges. These chips are ideal for attaching to mood boards, material samples, or technical specifications.

- **Keep Flat:** Store sheets flat to prevent bending, creasing, or warping, which can affect color perception and usability.
- **Protect from Moisture:** Humidity and moisture can damage the paper and lacquer coating. Store in a dry environment.
- **Handle with Care:** Avoid touching the colored surface directly to prevent oils from hands from affecting the color or finish.
- **Regular Replacement:** Over time, even with proper care, colors can subtly shift. For critical color work, consider replacing sheets periodically to ensure maximum accuracy.
