Awei B925BL Bluetooth Headset User Manual

Model: B925BL

INTRODUCTION

The Awei B925BL is a wireless Bluetooth headset designed for hands-free audio and communication. It features an in-ear design with ear hooks for secure fit, magnetic earbuds for convenient storage, and an inline control with a built-in microphone. This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper use and maintenance of your headset.

SETUP

What's in the Box

- Awei B925BL Bluetooth Headset
- Earbuds (various sizes)
- USB Charging Cable
- User Manual

Charging the Headset

1. Connect the micro USB end of the charging cable to the charging port on the headset's inline control.
2. Connect the USB-A end of the charging cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The indicator light will illuminate during charging.
4. Charging typically takes approximately 1.5 hours. The indicator light will change or turn off once charging is complete.

Pairing with a Bluetooth Device

1. Ensure the headset is fully charged.
2. Press and hold the Multi-function button (usually the center button on the inline control) for approximately 5-7 seconds until the indicator light flashes red and blue alternately. This indicates pairing mode.
3. On your mobile device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "Awei B925BL" from the list of found devices.
5. Once connected, the indicator light on the headset will typically flash blue slowly or turn off, and you will hear an audible confirmation.

6. If prompted for a password, enter "0000".

Wearing the Headset

Place the earbuds into your ears and adjust the ear hooks over your ears for a secure and comfortable fit. The ear hooks help to keep the headset stable during physical activity.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Controls Overview

The headset features an inline control unit with multiple buttons for managing audio and calls.

- **Multi-function Button (Center):** Power On/Off, Play/Pause, Answer/End Call, Reject Call, Redial.
- **Volume Up (+):** Increase volume, Next track (long press).
- **Volume Down (-):** Decrease volume, Previous track (long press).

Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Multi-function button for approximately 3 seconds until the indicator light flashes blue and you hear a power-on prompt.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Multi-function button for approximately 3-5 seconds until the indicator light flashes red and you hear a power-off prompt.

Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Next Track:** Long press the Volume Up (+) button.
- **Previous Track:** Long press the Volume Down (-) button.
- **Volume Adjustment:** Short press the Volume Up (+) or Volume Down (-) buttons.

Call Management

- **Answer Call:** Press the Multi-function button once when a call comes in.
- **End Call:** Press the Multi-function button once during a call.
- **Reject Call:** Long press the Multi-function button for approximately 2 seconds when a call comes in.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the Multi-function button.

Magnetic Earbuds

The earbuds feature magnets, allowing them to snap together when not in use. This helps prevent tangling and provides a secure way to wear the headset around your neck.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Wipe the headset with a soft, dry, or slightly damp cloth.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, cleaning solvents, or strong detergents.
- Remove ear tips and clean them separately with mild soap and water if necessary, ensuring they are completely dry before reattaching.

Storage

- When not in use, store the headset in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid storing the headset with sharp objects that could damage the cables or earbuds.

Battery Care

- Charge the headset regularly, even if not in frequent use, to maintain battery health.
- Avoid fully discharging the battery for extended periods.
- Do not expose the battery to high temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Headset does not power on.	Ensure the headset is fully charged. Connect it to a power source and try again after a few minutes.
Cannot pair with device.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Ensure the headset is in pairing mode (red and blue indicator lights flashing alternately).2. Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.3. Move the headset closer to your device (within 10 meters).4. Turn off and on your device's Bluetooth, then try pairing again.5. Clear previous Bluetooth connections on your device if necessary.
No sound or low volume.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Increase the volume on both the headset and your connected device.2. Ensure the headset is properly connected to your device.3. Check if the audio output on your device is set to the Bluetooth headset.
Call quality is poor.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Ensure the microphone is not obstructed.2. Move closer to your connected device.3. Avoid environments with strong electromagnetic interference.
Short battery life.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Ensure the headset is fully charged before use.2. Battery performance can degrade over time with usage.3. Operating at high volumes can reduce battery life.
