GENIUS KILO TX4 JLC 868 MHZ Remote Control User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your GENIUS KILO TX4 JLC 868 MHZ remote control. Please read this manual carefully before using the device to ensure proper function and safety.

The GENIUS KILO TX4 JLC remote control is designed for individual gate and garage door systems.

Important: This remote control is not compatible with collective residential or parking systems.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Keep the remote control out of reach of children to prevent accidental operation.
- Do not expose the remote control to water, extreme temperatures, or direct sunlight.
- Handle batteries according to manufacturer's instructions. Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- If the remote control is damaged, do not attempt to repair it yourself. Contact support for assistance.
- Ensure the gate or garage door area is clear before operating the remote control.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The GENIUS KILO TX4 JLC 868 MHZ remote control is a compact device designed for convenient operation of your gate or garage door. It features four distinct buttons for controlling different functions or multiple devices.

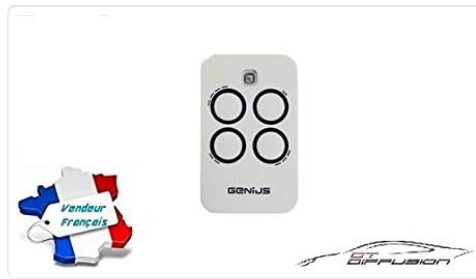

4. SETUP

4.1 Battery Installation

The remote control is supplied with an alkaline battery. To install or replace the battery:

1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
2. Carefully open the compartment using a small screwdriver or coin if necessary.
3. Insert the new alkaline battery, ensuring correct polarity (+ and -).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

4.2 Programming the Remote Control

- **Indicator Light:** The small indicator light on the remote control will illuminate when a button is pressed, confirming signal transmission.

Ensure you are within effective range of your receiver unit for reliable operation.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the remote control with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace the battery when the remote control's range decreases significantly or the indicator light becomes dim or fails to illuminate. Refer to Section 4.1 for battery installation instructions.
- **Storage:** Store the remote control in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote control does not work.	Dead or incorrectly installed battery.	Check battery polarity or replace the battery (refer to Section 4.1).
Remote control does not work.	Remote control is not programmed or has lost its programming.	Reprogram the remote control (refer to Section 4.2 and your opener's manual).
Reduced operating range.	Low battery or interference.	Replace the battery. Ensure there are no large metal objects or strong radio signals interfering with the remote.
Indicator light does not illuminate.	Dead battery.	Replace the battery.
