SETUP

1. Unpacking

No response from controls.	Unit frozen; low battery (if applicable); software glitch.	Perform a hard reset (refer to specific model instructions); charge the unit; restart the unit.
Poor performance.	Outdated firmware; interference; environmental factors.	Check for firmware updates; ensure proper ventilation; relocate the unit away from interference sources.
