1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

It features a functional steering wheel with a horn, an opening hood for simulated engine checks, and a detachable trailer for hauling various materials.

- **Safe Environment:** Use on flat, stable surfaces away from roads, steep inclines, steps, swimming pools, or other hazards.
- **Protective Gear:** Consider using a helmet and other protective gear, especially for younger or less experienced riders.

3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Although the product is not a 'do-it-yourself' kit from raw materials, some assembly of pre-fabricated components is required. Please follow these steps carefully. It is recommended to have a Phillips head screwdriver, a flathead screwdriver, and a hammer for certain steps, as indicated in the original product reviews.

Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Verify that all components are present and undamaged.
2. **Attach Front Axle and Steering:** Secure the front axle to the tractor body. Install the steering column and connect it to the front wheels, ensuring smooth directional movement.
3. **Install Wheels:** Attach the wheels to their respective axles. Pay attention to the orientation of the wheels (front/rear, left/right) and ensure they are securely fastened. Some parts may require firm tapping with a hammer for a secure fit.
4. **Mount Seat:** Securely attach the seat to the tractor body.
5. **Assemble Trailer:** Connect the trailer bed to its axle and wheels. Ensure the hitch mechanism is correctly assembled for easy attachment and detachment from the tractor.
6. **Apply Decals:** Carefully apply any provided decals or stickers to the designated areas on the tractor and trailer. Refer to the product images for correct placement.

7. **Final Check:** Before first use, double-check all connections, screws, and moving parts to ensure they are securely fastened and functioning correctly.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled and safety checked, your child can begin to enjoy their Falk Claas Pedal Tractor.

Basic Operation:

- **Pedaling:** Instruct your child to place their feet on the pedals and push alternately to move the tractor forward.
- **Steering:** The steering wheel controls the direction of the front wheels. Teach your child to turn the wheel left to go left and right to go right.
- **Horn:** The steering wheel is equipped with a horn. Press it to make a sound.
- **Using the Trailer:** The trailer can be easily attached to the back of the tractor. It is designed for carrying light loads such as sand, leaves, small toys, or garden produce. Ensure the trailer is securely attached before use.
- **Opening Hood:** The hood can be lifted to simulate engine inspection or repair, enhancing imaginative play.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and safe operation of your pedal tractor.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the tractor and trailer regularly with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all nuts, bolts, and screws to ensure they are tight. Inspect wheels, pedals, and steering components for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage.
- **Lubrication:** Moving parts, such as the pedal mechanism and steering joints, may benefit from occasional

lubrication with a silicone-based spray to ensure smooth operation.

- **Storage:** Store the tractor in a dry, sheltered area when not in use to protect it from extreme weather conditions, which can prolong its lifespan.
- **Simulated Maintenance:** Encourage children to use the opening hood feature for their own 'simulated maintenance' activities, such as 'changing spark plugs' or 'performing oil changes', as part of their imaginative play.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your pedal tractor, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Pedals are stiff or not moving smoothly.	Dirt or debris in the pedal mechanism; lack of lubrication.	Clean the pedal area. Apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to the moving parts of the pedal mechanism.
Steering is difficult or unresponsive.	Loose steering components; debris in steering mechanism.	Check all connections in the steering assembly and tighten if necessary. Clear any obstructions.
Trailer detaches easily or is difficult to attach.	Hitch mechanism not properly aligned or damaged.	Ensure the hitch is clean and free of debris. Verify that the hitch components are correctly assembled and undamaged.
Wheels wobble or are loose.	Axle caps or fasteners are loose.	Tighten the axle caps or fasteners. If damage is present, contact customer support for replacement parts.
