## 1. Introduction

---

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your CRENDA XPE496 Mini Projector. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference. The CRENDA XPE496 is a portable video projector designed for versatile entertainment and presentation needs, supporting Full HD 1080P resolution and a large display size.

### 3. Product Features

- **High Resolution Display:** Supports Full HD 1080P video with a projection size ranging from 28 to 180 inches, offering enhanced clarity and brightness.
- **Broad Compatibility:** Connects with various devices including PCs, Macs, TVs, Amazon Fire Stick, Roku, iPhones, iPads, and gaming consoles.
- **Quiet Operation:** Features an enhanced cooling and fan system designed for reduced noise levels, providing a more immersive viewing experience.
- **Extended Lamp Life:** Utilizes LED technology with a lamp life of up to 50,000 hours, ensuring long-term performance without frequent bulb replacement.
- **Integrated Audio:** Equipped with a built-in speaker for convenient audio output.
- **Portable Design:** Compact and lightweight, making it easy to transport and set up in various indoor or outdoor environments.

### 4. Setup

Follow these steps to set up your CRENOVA XPE496 Mini Projector:

1. **Power Connection:** Connect the power adapter to the projector's power input port and then plug it into a power outlet. The power indicator light will illuminate.
2. **Positioning:** Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. For optimal viewing, ensure the projector is perpendicular to your projection surface (wall or screen). Use the adjustable foot on the bottom of the projector to fine-tune the projection angle.
3. **Focus Adjustment:** Turn the FOCUS knob located on the top of the projector until the projected image is clear and sharp.
4. **Keystone Correction:** Adjust the KEYSTONE ring (if available, typically near the focus knob) to correct any trapezoidal distortion in the image, ensuring a rectangular display.
5. **Connect Devices:** Use the appropriate cables (HDMI, AV, USB) to connect your desired media source (laptop, streaming device, USB drive) to the projector.

## 5. Operating Instructions

---

Once powered on and connected, navigate the projector's interface:

- **Power On/Off:** Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn the unit on or off.
- **Input Source Selection:** Use the 'Source' button on the remote or the projector's control panel to cycle through available input options (HDMI, AV, USB).
- **Menu Navigation:** Use the arrow keys and 'OK' button on the projector or remote to navigate through the on-screen menu for settings adjustments.
- **Volume Control:** Adjust the volume using the dedicated volume buttons on the remote control.

## 6. Connectivity

---

The CRENOVA XPE496 Mini Projector offers multiple connectivity options:

- **HDMI:** Connects to laptops, PCs, gaming consoles, streaming devices (e.g., Amazon Fire Stick, Roku).
- **USB:** For playing media directly from USB drives.
- **VGA:** Connects to older computers or devices.
- **AV:** For connecting to devices using composite video and stereo audio cables.
- **Audio Out:** A 3.5mm audio jack for connecting external speakers or headphones.

## 7. Maintenance

---

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your projector, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Lens Cleaning:** Gently clean the projector lens with a soft, lint-free cloth or lens cleaning paper. Avoid using abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- **Dust Removal:** Regularly clean the ventilation vents to prevent dust buildup, which can affect cooling and performance. Use a soft brush or compressed air.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the projector in a cool, dry place, ideally in its original packaging or a protective carrying case, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Power Off Properly:** Always power off the projector using the designated power button and allow it to cool down before unplugging or moving.

## 8. Troubleshooting

---

If you encounter issues with your projector, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Image:** Ensure the power cable is securely connected and the projector is powered on. Check the input source selection to match your connected device. Verify that the connected device is also powered on and outputting a signal.
- **Blurry Image:** Adjust the FOCUS knob until the image is sharp. Ensure the projector is placed at an appropriate distance from the projection surface.
- **Trapezoidal Image:** Use the KEYSTONE correction feature to adjust the image shape.
- **No Sound:** Check the projector's volume settings and ensure it is not muted. Verify that the audio cables are correctly connected. If using an external audio device, ensure it is properly connected and functioning.
- **Remote Control Not Working:** Check the batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the projector's IR receiver.
