INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the assembly, operation, maintenance, and safety of your YardLine Sky Climber II Playset. Designed for do-it-yourself installation, this playset offers a comprehensive outdoor play experience with features like a solid wood roof, wave slide, swings, and a rock climbing wall. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly or allowing children to use the playset.

SAFETY INFORMATION

The safety of children is paramount. Adhere to all safety guidelines to prevent injuries.

- **Adult Supervision:** Always supervise children while they are using the playset.
- **Proper Installation:** Ensure all components are securely fastened according to assembly instructions.
- **Safe Surfacing:** Install the playset over a shock-absorbing surface such as wood chips, sand, or rubber mulch, extending at least 6 feet (1.8 meters) in all directions from the playset perimeter.
- **Clearance:** Maintain a safe distance from fences, trees, power lines, and other structures.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check for loose bolts, worn ropes, damaged components, or splinters.
- **Weather Conditions:** Do not use the playset during wet conditions, strong winds, or extreme temperatures.
- **Age Appropriateness:** Ensure children using the playset are within the recommended age and weight limits. The maximum weight recommendation is 113 Kilograms.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The YardLine Sky Climber II Playset is designed for do-it-yourself assembly. Assembly is required. It is recommended to have at least two adults for assembly. All necessary hardware and detailed instructions are included with your playset kit.

Site Preparation:

- Choose a level site for installation.
- Ensure adequate space around the playset for safety zones. Refer to the dimensions diagram below.
- Clear the area of any obstacles, rocks, or debris.

Assembly Steps:

1. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list provided in your kit.
2. Sort hardware and lumber according to the assembly manual.
3. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly manual for constructing the main tower, swing beam, slide, and other accessories.
4. Ensure all bolts are tightened securely, but do not overtighten to avoid damaging the wood.
5. Install all safety caps and covers on exposed hardware.

DIMENSIONES

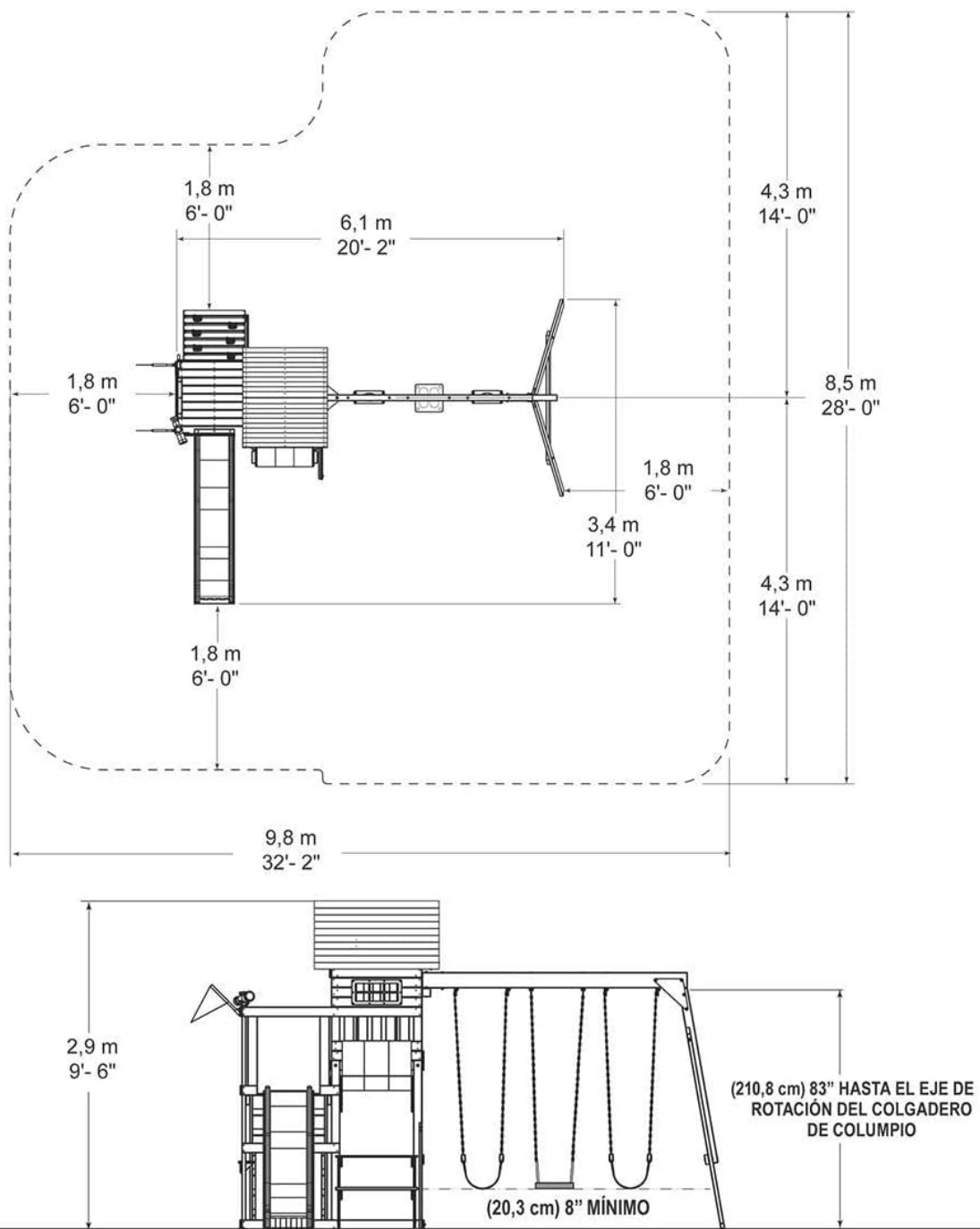


Figure 2: Dimensional diagram of the Sky Climber II Playset, indicating overall footprint and recommended safety zones. The playset measures approximately 49 x 3.81 x 69 cm (product dimensions) and requires a significant clear area for safe use.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial to ensure the longevity and safety of your playset.

- **Monthly Checks:**

- Inspect all nuts and bolts for tightness. Tighten as necessary.
- Check all protective coverings on bolts, pipes, edges, and corners. Replace if missing or damaged.
- Lubricate all metallic moving parts (e.g., swing hangers, chains) as needed.
- Inspect swing seats, ropes, and chains for wear or deterioration. Replace if signs of damage are present.

- **Seasonal Checks (Spring/Fall):**

- Clean the playset with a mild soap and water solution. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Inspect wood components for splinters, cracks, or rot. Sand down splinters and apply a non-toxic sealant or stain designed for outdoor wood if needed.

- Check the integrity of the ground anchors and ensure the playset remains level.
- Replenish or rake loose-fill surfacing material to maintain proper depth.
- **Winterization:** In colder climates, consider removing plastic components like swings and slides for storage indoors to prevent weather damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Playset feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose bolts or uneven ground.	Tighten all bolts. Ensure the playset is on a level surface; use shims if necessary. Check ground anchors.
Wood appears faded or rough.	Exposure to sun and weather.	Clean the wood and apply a suitable outdoor wood sealant or stain to protect it. Sand any rough spots or splinters.
Squeaking sounds from swings.	Dry or worn swing hangers/chains.	Apply a silicone-based lubricant to the swing hangers. Inspect chains for wear and replace if necessary.
Plastic components (slide, swings) are discolored or brittle.	UV exposure and age.	While some fading is normal, severe brittleness requires replacement of the component. Contact YardLine for replacement parts.
