# Daewoo RN-BH360NPW Refrigerator User Manual

Model: RN-BH360NPW

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your Daewoo RN-BH360NPW refrigerator. Please read these instructions thoroughly before installation and operation, and retain them for future reference. Proper installation, operation, and maintenance are crucial for optimal performance and longevity of the appliance.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To prevent personal injury or damage to the appliance, observe the following safety precautions:

- Ensure the appliance is properly grounded.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials, including tape and protective films. Dispose of packaging responsibly. Check the appliance for any signs of damage during transit.

### 3.2 Placement

- Place the refrigerator on a firm, level surface. Use the adjustable feet to ensure stability.
- Allow adequate space around the appliance for proper ventilation (at least 10 cm at the back and sides, and 30 cm above).
- Avoid direct sunlight and heat sources (e.g., radiators, ovens) to ensure efficient operation.
- Do not install in areas where the temperature is likely to fall below 10°C or rise above 38°C.

### 3.3 Electrical Connection

Connect the appliance to a dedicated, properly grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage and frequency match the specifications on the rating label. Do not use extension cords or multiple adapters.

### 3.4 Initial Cleaning

Before first use, clean the interior and exterior of the refrigerator with a soft cloth and a mild detergent solution. Rinse and dry thoroughly. Allow the appliance to stand for at least 2-4 hours after moving before plugging it in to allow refrigerants to settle.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Temperature Control

The refrigerator features an internal control panel, typically located at the top of the fresh food compartment. Use this panel to adjust the temperature settings for both the refrigerator and freezer sections. Refer to the specific markings on your appliance for precise adjustment methods. The recommended temperature for the refrigerator compartment is 3-5°C, and for the freezer compartment is -18°C.

### 4.2 Storage Compartments

- **Refrigerator Compartment:** This section is for fresh food storage. It includes adjustable glass shelves for flexible organization, door bins for beverages and smaller items, and a 'Vegetable Case' (crisper drawer) designed to maintain optimal humidity for fruits and vegetables.
- **Freezer Compartment:** Located at the bottom, this section is for long-term storage of frozen foods. It features multiple 'Frozen Case' drawers for easy separation and access to different types of frozen items.

### 4.3 NoFrost Feature

Your Daewoo RN-BH360NPW refrigerator is equipped with NoFrost technology in both the refrigerator and freezer compartments. This system prevents the build-up of ice, eliminating the need for manual defrosting and ensuring consistent cooling performance.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning

- **Interior:** Disconnect the power before cleaning. Clean the interior regularly with a solution of mild detergent and warm water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents. Remove shelves and drawers for thorough cleaning.
- **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn stains, use a mild, non-abrasive cleaner.
- **Door Seals:** Clean door seals regularly to ensure a tight seal. A dirty or damaged seal can lead to inefficient operation.

## 5.2 Power Outage Guidelines

In case of a power outage, keep the refrigerator and freezer doors closed as much as possible to maintain internal temperatures. Food can remain frozen for several hours depending on the ambient temperature and how full the freezer is. Do not refreeze thawed food.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting service, check the following common issues:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator not cooling	Power cord unplugged; temperature setting too high; door not closed properly.	Check power connection; adjust temperature; ensure door is fully closed.
Excessive noise	Appliance not level; items vibrating inside; compressor noise (normal).	Adjust leveling feet; rearrange items; normal compressor operation is expected.
Water on floor	Drain hole blocked; door not sealed properly.	Clear drain hole; check door seal for obstructions or damage.
